

PACIFIC

- Noah St. Urbain currently is second on the team with a .333 average and leads the team with a .690 slugging percentage.
- Nick Longmire leads the team with a .340 average, and Kurt Wideman leads the team with four home runs on the year. Wideman's 24 RBI lead the squad.
- Team owns a .256 team batting average and a .944 fielding percentage.
- Swept in their three-game series at UC Riverside last weekend.

STANFORD

- Currently in second place in the Pac-10 with an 10-5 mark, a half game behind Arizona State and two games ahead of third place Washington.
- Currently at No. 7 in the latest *Baseball America* poll released May 5.
- Has won 12 consecutive regular season three-game series for its longest streak of that kind since taking 15 straight series from May 3, 2003 - May 4, 2004.
- Stanford is currently on a two-game win streak after taking both games against San Jose State last weekend
- Has put up significantly better pitching (4.26) and fielding (.972) numbers than the 6.01 ERA and .963 fielding percentage of 2007
- Has outhomered its opponents, 49-33
