



2009 Football Parking Lot Policies

All of us at Stanford hope you will enjoy the traditions, excitement and spirit associated with a Cardinal home football game. We always strive to foster an amazing game-day atmosphere for those visiting our campus. In order to continue this, we need your cooperation.

We ask that all parking permit holders, as well as those without parking permits, to review the [2009 Parking & Tailgate Guide Map](#), as well as the Parking Lot Policies listed below.

Stanford University Department of Public Safety and American Parking Management are instructed to honor all parking permits in the correct locations and to help with expediting your approach to the lot assigned, provided that you display your permit properly. Unexpected traffic delays, weather conditions or heavy traffic approximately 60 minutes prior to kickoff will force changes in traffic patterns and parking availability. **Reserved Parking Areas are not guaranteed less than 60 minutes prior to kickoff.** Please cooperate in such an eventuality.

Parking Permit Holders that drive RECREATIONAL VEHICLES that would like to park overnight can only do so in Lot #2 (El Camino Grove). Lot#2 will open at 9:00 a.m. the Friday before game day. If you do not have a parking permit, you will not be able to enter. All other RVs will be directed to park in Lot # 7 and Lot #9.

Stanford University is concerned with monitoring safe and proper crowd control, not only in Stanford Stadium, but in the parking areas as well. As a result, we have taken this opportunity to restate our policies that are designed to (1) ensure the health and safety of all of our fans and guests, (2) insist on moderation in the consumption of alcoholic beverages and (3) eliminate all chances of abuse and the safety of all individuals.

Parking Lot Policies

1. Follow all instructions of the traffic control officers and parking personnel. Park in the next space beside the preceding car. Do not hold adjacent spaces for late arrivals.
2. Consumption of alcohol by minors is against the law and violators will be held responsible.
3. Verbal abuse, in any form, will not be tolerated.
4. Safety Officers, Traffic Control Officers and parking personnel will be on duty prior, during and post-events in and around the lots. In case of an emergency, please advise those individuals. If they cannot be located, please call 911.
5. Please dispose of all HOT CHARCOAL in designated hot coal bins located throughout the various parking lots.
6. Be safe.

With the purchase of football season tickets, ticket holders receive parking permits, which provide greater flexibility to park and tailgate with family and friends.

All parking is subject to availability and filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that detailed instructions are provided on the reverse side of your parking permit, indicating the best way to enter and leave the parking areas around Stanford Stadium.

Q: I'm a season ticket holder, where can I park on game day?

A: Season ticket holders have the flexibility to choose from any of the following season ticket permit lots or general public lots:

Q: How will construction located near Stanford Athletics facilities affect parking on game days?

A: Due to construction, approximately 1,000 parking spaces have been displaced in the former Serra Lot #12, which will be the site of the new Graduate School of Business Knight Management Center. The decrease in parking inventory will likely cause heavy traffic and parking delays along Campus Drive so we ask our fans to plan ahead, arrive early and cooperate with traffic control officers and parking attendants while arriving and leaving campus.

Q: How can I get extra parking permits?

A: For \$50, season ticket holders can purchase additional season ticket permits (limit two), which include access to all Season Ticket Lots. Please contact the Stanford Athletics Ticket Office at 1-800-STANFORD to purchase additional permits.

Q: How much does it cost to park at Stanford for football games?

A: All parking during Stanford home football games is free. While we do not charge for parking, general public parking is limited to four lots including IM South Lot #4, Arboretum Grove Lot #8, Lasuen Grove Lot #9, and Maple Lot #11.

Q: Where can I park my RV?

A: RV parking is available for season ticket holders in El Camino Grove Lot #2 and in Eucalyptus Grove Lot #10. General public RV parking is located in Lasuen Grove Lot #9.

Q: Is overnight parking available?

A: Overnight parking is available only to season ticket holders. The overnight parking lot is located at El Camino Grove Lot #2. The lot opens at 9:00 a.m. the Friday before game day.

Q: Which lot should I park in to tailgate?

A: Patrons can park and tailgate in any of the lots around Stanford Stadium. In fact, Stanford's shaded groves, manicured lawns, and free parking all contribute to a great tailgate experience.

Q: How do I secure a group tailgate spot?

A: Group tailgates can be arranged through Stanford Athletics Director of Ticket Sales. Please call Bob Wilmot at 650-736-8191 or email Bob at rwilmot@stanford.edu.

Q: Does Stanford offer a pre-game fan area?

A: Yes, Stanford Football Fan Fest offers food, interactive games, and live entertainment for free! Fan Fest is located at the Hammer Throw area between Stanford Stadium and Cobb Track & Angell Field. It opens three hours prior to kickoff.
