#### Up Next

The No. 7 Stanford men's golf team will begin play at the three-day, 54-hole 2008 NCAA Division I West Regional this Thursday, May 15 at the Gold Mountain Golf Club in Bremerton, Wash. The Cardinal will be looking to secure a top-ten finish out of 27 teams in order to earn a bid to defend last year's crown at the 2008 NCAA Championships, hosted by Purdue University at the Kampen Course in West Lafayette, Ind. from May 28-31.

Fifteen of the 27 teams selected for the NCAA West Regional are ranked in the top-50 by Golfweek, including Pac-10 foes UCLA, USC, Arizona State, and Oregon State. Stanford, which is paired with Clemson and UNLV, will begin play Thursday morning on the 10th tee of Gold Mountain's par-72, 7,111-yard Olympic Course at 11:48 a.m. when junior Dodge Kemmer tees off. Sophomore Jordan Cox will follow at 11:57 a.m., then freshman Steve Ziegler (12:07 p.m.), senior Rob Grube (12:16 p.m.), and freshman Sihwan Kim (12:26 p.m.).

#### The Field

The Field: The 27-team field is as follows in order of seed: No. 1 USC, No. 2 UCLA, No. 3 Florida State, No. 4 Stanford, No. 5 Clemson, No. 6 UNLV, No. 7 North Carolina, No. 8 Texas Tech, No. 9 Central Florida, No. 10 Arizona State, No. 11 San Diego State, No. 12 Texas, No. 13 LSU, No. 14 Oregon State, No. 15 Pepperdine, No. 16 Oregon, No. 17 California, No. 18 St. Mary's, No. 19 Kentucky, No. 20 Wisconsin, No. 21 Washington, No. 22 Oklahoma, No. 23 Kansas State, No. 24 San Diego, No. 25 Denver, No. 26 Navy, No. 27 Columbia. The individuals are Troy Merritt of Boise State, Brian Locke of Loyola Marymount, Tarquin MacManus of Arizona, Jason D'Amore of Loyola Marymount, Nathan Stamey of North Carolina-Greensboro and Jimmy Lytle of Elon.

#### Stanford So Far In 2007-08

Stanford has accumulated one top-10 and eight top-5 finishes in ten tournaments this year, winning the UH-Hilo Invitational on February 8. Stanford is the third highest Pac-10 ranked team behind No. 3 USC and No. 4 UCLA. The Cardinal most recently finished fifth at the 2008 Pac-10 Championships. The team is averaging 304.1 strokes per round, and has shot a low round of 263 and a tournament-low of 813.

#### Stanford In The NCAA Tournament

Should Stanford advance out of regional competition to the 2008 NCAA Championships, it will be their fourth trip in the last 10 seasons. Last year, before winning its eighth team title, the Cardinal finished seventh at the NCAA West Regional. Two Cardinal golfers have won individual championships: Sandy Tatum in 1942 and Tiger Woods in 1996.

#### STANFORD CARDINAL QUINTET NCAA WEST REGIONALS

##### SIHWAN KIM

2008 Pac-10 Freshman of the Year and first-team All-Pac-10 honoree Kim is the highest ranked Cardinal golfer, checking in at No. 12. He has taken to the fairways in every tournament Stanford has played thus far and holds the lowest stroke average of the team (71.4). He has amassed one even-par and 14 under-par rounds in 31 outings and has finished in the top-10 five times and the top-25 four times.

His best finish came at the CordeValle Collegiate in November when he tied for individual crown with two other golfers. He also holds the team's best low-round with 63 strokes, and is tied with teammate Grube for a tournament-low 199.

##### ROB GRUBE

No. 39 Grube is coming off a three-way tie for third place (shooting the second best four-round stroke total at the tournament) at the Pac-10 Championships, where he was awarded his fourth consecutive first-team All-Pac-10 award. In 10 tournaments this season, he has four top-10 and four top-25 finishes. His two best places came at the Pac-10 Championships and also at the UH-Hilo Invitational, where he tied for second with teammate Kim and shot his round and tournament lows of 65 and 199. He is currently averaging 72 strokes per round, and has notched three even-par and 10 under-par rounds.

##### STEVE ZIEGLER

Ziegler, ranked No. 89, has proven to be a force to reckon with in his rookie campaign. Save for a tie for 27th place most recently at the Pac-10 Championships, the All-Pac-10 honorable mention golfer has improved his finish with each tournament this spring, with his best finish coming as a tie for seventh at the U.S. Intercollegiate Invitational. He is averaging 73.1 strokes per round and has shot two even-par rounds and six under-par rounds, including two consecutive under-par rounds at the 2008 Pac-10 Championships, where he aced the 11th hole in the second round. He has a low-round best of 65 and a tournament-low of 211.

##### JORDAN COX

Cox has shot 25 rounds in eight events for the Cardinal, and is currently shooting 73.2 per round. He has shot even-par nine times, and under-par on four occasions. He has two top-10 and two top-25 performances. His round and tournament lows are 68 and 210, respectively.

##### DODGE KEMMER

Kemmer has played in all but one event this year for Stanford, and is averaging 74.6 strokes per round. He has recorded one even-par round, and five under-par rounds. He boasts two top-10 and three top-25 finishes, while stroking a low round of 66 and tournament-low 214.

#### THE KNOWLES FAMILY DIRECTOR OF MEN'S GOLF, HEAD COACH CONRAD RAY

Last season, Ray helmed one of the most successful Stanford teams in history, guiding the Cardinal to its first national title since 1994. Ray, a member of that 1994 squad, is one of the elite few NCAA head coaches to have won an NCAA title as both an athlete and coach. Under Ray's guidance, the Cardinal led wire-to-wire at the 2007 NCAA Championships in Williamsburg, Va. and claimed an eighth national title for the program. The 12-stroke victory capped an impressive season, during which the squad won seven tournaments and earned a No. 1 national ranking. All five Stanford golfers were named All-Americans at the conclusion of the season, the most to earn the honor in a single-season in program history. Additionally, the squad produced an Academic All-American, three Pac-10 All-Academic honorees, five All-Conference selections, five All-Region selections and a GCAA All-Freshman selection. Ray was named the 2007 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, the Pacific Regional Coach of the Year and the Dave Williams/Eaton Golfpride National Coach of the Year following the 2007 campaign.

In 2005-06, Ray's second year at the helm of the program, the Cardinal posted ten top-10 finishes and advanced to the NCAA West Regional in Tucson, Ariz. Sophomore Rob Grube was tabbed Pac-10 Co-Player of the Year and was honored as an All-American for the second time in his career.

In his first season on the Farm, Ray led his squad its first NCAA Championship appearance since 2001. Under Ray's leadership, Stanford tied for 18th overall while freshman Rob Grube tied for fifth individually, becoming the first Stanford golfer to record a top-five finish since 1998.

Ray is a 1997 graduate of Stanford University where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Public Policy. A three-year letterwinner for the Cardinal golf team, Ray was a member of the 1994 NCAA Championship squad and a teammate of Tiger Woods, Casey Martin and Notah Begay. He captained the team in 1997 and was an All-Pac-10 and Pac-10 All-Academic selection that season as well. As a senior, he posted six top-10 finishes and nine under-par rounds. Ray's 73.95 stroke average was second-best on the squad.

Ray was tapped to play in the U.S. Open at Pinehurst in June 2005. He has played on the Nationwide Tour and other world tours since 1998 and achieved 12 top-10 finishes in that span. He has worked extensively with numerous golf instructors throughout the country and has organized and administered various pro-am and fund-raising golf tournaments, including the Karl Potach Memorial Tournament for children's cancer research and the Bart McCormick Classic. Ray has been a member of the Golf Coaches Association National Advisory Board since July 2006.

Ray is married to the former Jennifer Woods and has a one-year-old daughter, Ella Katherine Ray.
