Stanford improved to 2-0 overall, as the Taube Family Tennis Stadium is one 15 host sites around the country for this weekend's tournament. The ITA Kick-Off Weekend features four teams at each site vying to advance to the National Team Indoor Championships on Feb. 12-15.

The Cardinal wasted little time putting away the Seahawks (1-1, 0-0 Colonial), capturing the doubles point and winning six straight singles matches.
