STANFORD SENIORS TO PLAY FINAL REGULAR SEASON

HOME MATCHES THIS WEEKEND: Cardinal seniors **Ali Ansari (Houston, TX/Second Baptist HS)**, **Alex Kim (Potomac, MD/Winston Churchill HS)** and **Scotty Scott (Belvedere, CA/Pinewood School)**

will play the final home regular season matches of their career this weekend at the Taube Family Tennis Stadium as Bank of the West presents "The Stanford Challenge" ... Stanford hosts #18 USC (13-6 overall, 3-4) on Friday at 1:30 p.m. and #1 UCLA (18-1, 6-1) on Saturday at noon in non-conference action ... Saturday's match will be aired live in the Palo Alto area on the Stanford Channel, and can be seen via live webcast at <http://tsc.stanford.edu> ... Earlier this month in Los Angeles, the Cardinal defeated the Bruins 4-3 (April 6) and the Trojans 4-2 (April 7) en route to a perfect 7-0 conference mark and its fifth straight Pac-10 title ... Ansari, Kim and Scott have not lost a home dual match in their four-year career on The Farm (50-0) ... Overall, Stanford has won 68 straight at the Taube Family Tennis Stadium dating all the way back to April 6, 1996 .

SENIOR SALUTE: The accomplishments of Stanford's senior class of 2001 are staggering ... **Ali Ansari**, **Alex Kim** and **Scotty Scott** have led Stanford to two of a possible three NCAA Championships (1998 & 2000), four out of a possible four Pacific-10 Conference titles (1998-2001), and have not lost a home dual during their illustrious careers ... Kim is the defending NCAA Singles Champion and currently the top-ranked player in the nation ... He enters the weekend with a 21-2 singles record this spring (16-2 in duals) and an amazing career mark of 128-22 (75-11 in duals) ... In fact, Kim's career dual winning percentage of .872 ranks 10th in school history ... Ansari and Scott have been tough to beat both as a team and individually ... As a doubles team, Ansari and Scott are 22-7 this season (9-2 in duals) and captured the Sherwood Collegiate Cup title in January ... Individually, Ansari has won a career-best 25 matches this season (25-5) ... He won the consolation singles title at the Sherwood Collegiate Cup and was a semifinalist at the ITA Regional in November ... Scott was a catalyst in Stanford's national team title run last season, and provided the clinching singles win in the championship match vs. Virginia Commonwealth ... He was named to the 2000 NCAA All-Tournament team, and has continued to excel this year with an 18-6 mark (9-3 in duals).

night's 5-2 home win over Pepperdine ... Gould is an amazing 707-129 (.846) in 34-plus seasons to surpass **Dan Magill** of Georgia ... Magill retired with a career mark of 706-183 ... Gould now trails only **Jim Schwitters** (Hawaii), **Jim Verdieck** (Redlands) and **Norm Copeland** (Rollins) on the all-time victory list ... Schwitters, who is still active, entered the year with an all-time men's mark of 789-386-8 with many of those wins coming at the non-Division I level ... Gould, who was named ITA/Wilson Intercollegiate Coach of the Decade for both the 1980's and '90's, has led Stanford to 17 NCAA Team Championships, as well as coaching 10 national singles champions and six doubles champions.

THE RANKINGS: Though it has won 13 matches in a row, Stanford dropped one spot to #5 in the latest WingspanBank.com Collegiate Team Rankings (April 18) ... Stanford was #1 in the country from the pre-season through Feb. 20, #2 from Feb. 21-March 13, #7 from March 14-27, #6 from March 28-April 11 and #4 from April 12-17 ... Before dropping to #2, the Cardinal had held the nation's top spot since April 12, 2000 ... In the latest ITA Individual Rankings (April 18), Stanford owns four of the top 100 spots in singles and three of the top 50 slots in doubles ... In fact, seven of the 10 players on Stanford's roster are nationally-ranked in singles and/or doubles ... In singles, defending NCAA Champion **Alex Kim** has jumped back to #1 for the first time since the ITA Preseason Rankings on Sept. 11 ... Junior **K.J. Hippensteel (Roanoke, VA/International Academy)** is next at #25, followed by sophomore **David Martin (Boca Raton, FL/Key Biscayne Prep)** at #41 and sophomore **Ryan Haviland (Sumter, SC/Sumter HS)** at #97 ... On the doubles side, sophomores **Scott Lipsky (Merrick, NY/Bellmore-Kennedy HS)** and Martin are at No. 6, marking their fifth straight ranking period in the top 10 ... Hippensteel and Kim are #24, while seniors **Ali Ansari** and **Scotty Scott** are seven slots back at #31.

DUALLY NOTED: Stanford is 19-1 overall and won its fifth straight Pacific-10 Conference with a perfect 7-0 record ... The fifth-ranked Cardinal is only one win shy of its 14th consecutive 20-win season ... Stanford, which is 9-0 on its home court this year, has won 13 straight matches dating back to February 23 ... During the streak, Stanford has outscored its opposition 76-13 ... Already this season, the Cardinal owns wins over #1 UCLA, #3 Duke, #15 Pepperdine, #16 Washington, #18 USC and #21 California ... The Cardinal also finished second in the USTA/ITA National Team Indoor Championships in Seattle on Feb. 15-18 ... The Cardinal advanced to the finals with shutout wins over Princeton, Florida and Duke before falling to UCLA 4-2 in the finals.
