STANFORD, Calif. – UC Santa Barbara used a four-goal fourth period to blow open a 4-4 deadlock and advance to Sunday's fifth-place game with an 8-5 win over Pacific at the MPSF Tournament Saturday at Avery Aquatic Center.

The teams traded goals over the first half, playing to a 2-2 tie. UCSB scored the first two of the second half to go up 4-2 before Pacific struck for two of its own to bring it back to even after three periods.

But three straight goals to open the fourth frame, two of those coming from Matt Gronow, put the Gauchos ahead 7-4, a deficit which Pacific could not overcome. Gronow and Lazar Komadinic each scored twice to lead the Gauchos. Balasz Szabo led the Tigers with two goals.

Fraser Bunn made 12 saves in the UCSB cage while Pacific's Alex Malkis stopped 10 shots.

UC Santa Barbara will now play UC Irvine in Sunday's Fifth Place Game at 11:30 a.m. Pacific will battle Pepperdine in the 10 a.m. Seventh Place Game.
