Southeast Missouri State Coach B.J. Smith: In his fourth season in Cape Girardeau, Smith owns a 79-40 record. In his eighth season as a head coach, she holds a 193-60 mark.

VANDERVEER'S VICTORIES...

Tara VanDerveer became the ninth Division-I coach to reach the 650 milestone last Saturday (Feb. 4) with an 87-54 victory over Oregon State. Two games later at Cal on Feb. 11, VanDerveer won her 500th as the Stanford head coach. One of the winningest active coaches, her overall record stands at 657-178 (.787) in 27 years, while her record at Stanford is 505-127 (.799) in 20 years.

500 CLUB...

If Brooke Smith scores one more point this season, it will be just the fifth time that Stanford has had two players score 500 or more points in the same season, and the first time since 2001-02 when Nicole Powell scored 581 points and Lindsey Yamasaki added 551. The other duos to both score 500 points were: Kate Starbird and Olympia Scott in 1996-97; Julie Zeilstra and Sonja Henning in 1990-91; and Meg Metzger and Jeanne Ruark Hoff in 1982-83.

CANDICE CORNER...

Sophomore **Candice Wiggins** became the 26th player in Stanford history to score 1,000 points with her first basket at USC. Through 65 games, Wiggins has scored 1,248 points, which ranks 20th on the all-time scoring list. Cardinal junior Brooke Smith will be the next Stanford player to reach the milestone, as she has 964 points in her 65 games.

NCAA NOTES...

Stanford is 43-17 all-time in NCAA Tournament action and is making its 19th consecutive appearance and 20th overall. The Cardinal advanced to the Elite Eight in each of the last two seasons. The Cardinal has won two National Championships, and advanced to six Final Fours, 10 Elite Eights and 13 Sweet 16s.

* The Seminoles were eliminated in the first round of their conference tournament, but were one of seven ACC teams to receive a bid to the NCAA Tournament.

* Florida State owns a 3-5 record in NCAA action and is making its sixth appearance in the NCAA Tournament this year.

THE STANFORD-FLORIDA STATE SERIES...

This would be the second meeting between the two schools. The Cardinal and the Seminoles faced off at the Dial Classic in Miami, Fla., on Jan. 3, 1984, with Florida State taking a 73-50 victory over Stanford.

STANFORD VS. THE ACC...

The Cardinal owns an overall record of 9-6 (.600) against current Atlantic Coast Conference foes. Stanford has faced seven of the 12 current members and boasts winning records against four of the squads. The Cardinal lost a 77-69 decision to Boston College in December.

 * Louisiana Tech is ranked in the top-20 in both national polls, but received a No. 11 seed in the San Antonio region.

THE STANFORD-LOUISIANA TECH SERIES...

This would be just the second match-up between the two schools. On March 25, 1989, Louisiana Tech knocked the Cardinal out of the NCAA Tournament in the Elite Eight, 85-75.

STANFORD VS. THE WAC...

The Cardinal is 38-21 all-time against Western Athletic Conference foes. Stanford has faced off against every team except two in the league and owns winning records against five opponents. The Cardinal has never matched up against Boise State or New Mexico State. Stanford faced a WAC opponent in November, besting Fresno State 89-67 on Nov. 23 in Maples.

Tara VanDerveer

At Stanford: in 20th season, 505-127 (.799)

Overall Record: 27th season, 657-178 (.787)

In a storied 27-year coaching career, Tara VanDerveer has established herself as one of the top coaches in the history of both collegiate and international women's basketball.

VanDerveer's enormous contributions to the sport were recognized in April 2002, as she was inducted into the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame in Knoxville, Tenn.

VanDerveer, the 2006 Pac-10 Coach of the Year, has accumulated an impressive 657-178 (.787) record in her 27 years of collegiate coaching. VanDerveer entered the 2005-06 campaign with the third highest career winning percentage among active Division I women's basketball coaches and has won two NCAA Championships and 18 conference titles (including this season). This year's trip to the NCAA Tournament is the 21st post-season appearance in her career.

In her 20th year as the head coach of the Stanford women's basketball program, she owns an amazing 505-127 (.799) record. During her tenure on The Farm, she has led the Cardinal to two NCAA Championships, five NCAA Final Four appearances, 14 Pacific-10 Conference titles and 18 consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament. Last season, the Cardinal advanced to the Elite Eight for the ninth time under VanDerveer's tutelage.

VanDerveer's contributions to the sport of women's basketball reach far outside the collegiate world. She became internationally known in 1996 when she guided the United States Olympic Women's Basketball Team to the gold medal in Atlanta. VanDerveer led the National/Olympic team, which included Stanford products Jennifer Azzi and Katy Steding, to an incredible 60-0 record from 1995-1996. In all, VanDerveer has compiled an 88-8 (.917) record, including four gold medals, in eight head coaching stints with USA Basketball.

The coaching great paved the way for many more Stanford milestones in 2001 by signing a multi-year contract extension that will keep her on The Farm through March 31, 2007.

VanDerveer at Stanford

VanDerveer, who was named the third women's basketball coach in Stanford University history on May 7, 1985, has guided the Cardinal to a 505-127 (.799) record in 20 seasons, including a 288-54 (.842) record in regular season Pac-10 play.

Under her leadership, Stanford has captured two NCAA Titles and made five

Final Four appearances. Additionally, her teams have reached the Elite Eight nine times and the Sweet Sixteen 12 times. Since 1987-88, VanDerveer's teams are 39-15 (.722) in NCAA Tournament play. With a 32-3 record in 2004-05, the Cardinal has won 30 or more games six times and with a 23-7 record this season, Stanford has won 20 or more games 16 times under VanDerveer's guidance.

VanDerveer's teams have also compiled a 272-29 (.904) home record during her tenure, and, with a 13-0 mark in 2004-05, have posted seven perfect seasons at Maples Pavilion.

Stanford teams have been dominant in both the Pac-10 and nationally, as evident by VanDerveer's numerous awards. She is a three-time National Coach of the Year (1987-88, 1988-89, 1989-90) and District Coach of the Year (1987-88, 1988-89, 1989-90), and has been named Pac-10 Coach of the Year on eight occasions (1988-89, 1989-90, 1994-95, 1996-97, 2001-02, 2002-03, 2004-05, 2005-06). Additionally, VanDerveer earned Northern California Women's Intercollegiate Coach of the Year honors five times in a six-year span in the late 80's and early 90's (1987-88, 1988-89, 1989-90, 1991-92, 1992-93).

NCAA Champions

VanDerveer earned her first NCAA Championship in 1989-90, after the Cardinal won its first 20 games en route to a 32-1 overall mark. Stanford set more than 100 school, Pac-10 and NCAA postseason records during that campaign. After defeating Mississippi and Arkansas in the NCAA West Regional at Maples Pavilion, the Cardinal continued to roll with a 75-66 win over Virginia in the semifinals and an 88-81 victory over Auburn in the final to capture its first-ever NCAA title.

The Cardinal earned its second championship in 1991-92, despite the loss of three First-Team All-Pac-10 players (Sonja Henning, Trisha Stevens and Julie Zeilstra) from the previous season. The Cardinal won its first 10 games, finished 15-3 in conference play to win its fourth straight Pac-10 title, and went into the NCAA Tournament on an upswing behind the play of Kodak First-Team All-American Val Whiting. Stanford defeated Western Kentucky, 78-62, in the championship game to end the season with its second national title in three years and a 30-3 record.

THREE SEED THOUGHTS...

Stanford is 1-1 as a No. 3 seed in the NCAA Tournament. The Cardinal's only other selection as a three seed was in 2002-03. That season, Stanford hosted the first and second rounds at Maples Pavilion, but lost in the second round. The Cardinal defeated Western Michigan in the opener and then lost a 68-56 contest to Minnesota in the second round.

PAC-10 PARTICIPANTS...

Six Pacific-10 teams will represent the conference in this year's NCAA Tournament, as UCLA won the automatic bid and Arizona State, California, Stanford, USC and Washington all earned at-large bids. It is the first time in league history that the Pac-10 has sent six teams to the NCAA Tournament. The Pac-10 had sent five teams to the tournament six times. Last season, the Pac-10 sent five teams and all of them won their opening games, the first time in league history that Pac-10 teams won all five first round games. This year, Only the ACC (7) and the Big East (6) are sending more teams. The Southeastern is also sending six teams.

TWENTY TIME...

With the 100-69 victory over Washington on Feb. 23, Stanford has posted its 17th season with 20 or more wins. Stanford has won 20+ games in each of the last five seasons and six of the last seven.

RANKINGS REPORT...

Stanford began the 2005-06 season with a No. 11 ranking in the AP poll and a No. 10 ranking in the USA Today/ESPN/WBCA Coaches' poll. Prior to its first game, Stanford moved up to No. 9 in the USA Today poll - its highest ranking this season. The Cardinal moved up from its lowest ranking this year (16th) with a five-game winning streak to 11th in the AP poll and 12th in the USA Today poll, but a road loss at Arizona State put the Cardinal back at 15th in both polls. After winning the Pac-10 regular season title and falling in overtime in the tournament title game, Stanford is No. 13/14.

STRONG FINISHES...

With the 78-47 win over Washington State on Feb. 25, Stanford has won its regular season home finale in each of the last 18 years.

A LOT ALLOWED...

The Cardinal gave up 90 points in the Jan. 27 loss at UCLA, the most points allowed by the Cardinal this season. It is the first time Stanford has given up 90 points since Feb. 24, 2001, when the Cardinal lost 95-87 at Washington. That season, Stanford gave up 90 points or more in three games (a 30-point loss at No. 8 Purdue and a four-point overtime loss at No. 22 Oklahoma).

NOT A LOT ALLOWED...

The Cardinal held an opponent to 17 for the second time this season as Stanford limited Cal to just 17 first half points in Berkeley on Feb. 11. The Cardinal also held Long Island to 17 first half points in the season opener. But against the Golden Bears it went both ways, as Stanford scored a season-low 22 points in the first half at Haas. The Cardinal ended the game with a season-low 55 points. Stanford is 14-0 on the year when holding opponents to 60 or fewer points, and 6-0 when the Cardinal's foes scored 50 or fewer.

SHOOTING FROM THE OUTSIDE...

Stanford is ranked No. 3 in the nation in three-point field-goal percentage, with the Cardinal making 40.0% of its threes. And Stanford is shooting a lot from the outside, hitting at least eight three-pointers in a game 13 times this season - and making 10 against Fresno State, at Pacific and at Washington, 11 against Washington at home, and knocking down 14 against Cal. Against Fresno State and Pacific, **Krista Rappahahn** was nine-for-ten from behind the three-point line, and against the Huskies, she hit a career-high six threes in a game. Sophomore guard **Candice Wiggins** has hit seven three in a game twice this season -- against Cal and Washington (both in Maples). Against the Huskies, she was 7-for-10 from beyond the arc. Rappahahn and Wiggins are both strong beyond the arc, as both are hitting 43.9% of their shots this season and ranked No. 11 and 12, respectively.

NATIONAL NEWS...

Brooke Smith and **Candice Wiggins** have both been named as finalists for the 2006 Kodak/WBCA All-America Basketball Team, as announced by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), in cooperation with Eastman Kodak Company. Smith and Wiggins are among 48 finalists, who are voted upon by WBCA member coaches in each of the eight WBCA geographical regions, and are now in the running for selection to the 10-member Kodak/WBCA All-America Team, will be announced at the Kodak/WBCA All-America Team Press Conference on April 1, 2006 at 9:45 a.m. (ET) in Boston.

CARDINAL CATALOGUE...

Two Cardinal players are scoring in double digits and just six are averaging at least 21.7 minutes per game - although no player is averaging more than 31.3 minutes. Through all games on March 12, Stanford is ranked No. 3 in the nation in three-point field goal percentage as the Cardinal is shooting 40.0% from beyond the arc, and No. 5 in the nation in scoring offense, with 78.8 points per game. The Cardinal is also in the top-25 nationally in scoring margin (No. 9, 15.9 ppg), assists (No. 9, 17.5 apg), field-goal percentage (No. 11, 46.8%) and three-point field goals per game (No. 13, 7.2 pg). **Candice Wiggins** is ranked No. 10 in the country in scoring with 21.2 points per game and is No. 12 in the country in three-point field-goal percentage at 43.9%, while **Krista Rappahahn** is ranked No. 11 in the nation in three-point percentage, shooting 43.9%. Rappahahn and Wiggins are also ranked in threes per game, making an average of 2.8 and 2.6 threes per contest, respectively (No. 16 & No. 25). **Brooke Smith** is among the nation's best in field-goal percentage, ranked No. 18 with a 57.3% average.

PAC-10 PRIDE...

In the preseason, the coaches picked Stanford to win the conference, with nine first-place votes (81 points). It was the sixth-consecutive time and sixth time overall that Stanford has been favored by the coaches to win the Conference title since the poll's inception in 1998-99. The Cardinal has won the regular season conference title each year that the coaches picked Stanford to finish first.

STANFORD SAGA...

Stanford owns a 23-7 record this season, and posted a 15-3 mark in Pac-10 action. The Cardinal won the Pac-10 regular season title and secured the No. 1 seed at the Pac-10 Tournament. It is the 15th championship in 20 Pac-10 seasons and the sixth-straight regular season conference crown (a new record, besting the previous five won by Stanford from 1989-93). The Cardinal has played in all five Pac-10 Tournament title games and has won the crown three times.

FREE THROW LOWS...

Stanford is shooting 66.7% from the free throw line, the second-worst average in program history (since the stat began being kept in 1978-79). The worst free-throw shooting by a Cardinal team on record was in 1978-79, when Stanford went 64.8% from the charity strike. The Cardinal has not shot less than 70% since the 1999-2000 season when the squad finished the campaign with a 69.9% average. Stanford's free throw percentage has been below 70% since the Tennessee game on Dec. 4.

FREE THROW HIGHS...

Against Arizona State, the Cardinal shot a season-high 32 free throws and made a season-high 26, with sophomore **Candice Wiggins** leading the way, going 16-for-19 from the charity strike, which ties the school record for makes in a single game and sets a new mark for attempts. She now leads the Pac-10 in free-throw percentage. Wiggins longest streak was 23-straight free throws over a four game stretch (last four at USC, all nine against Oregon, all six against Oregon State, first three against UCSB).

BACK-TO-BACK DISAPPOINTMENT...

In December, Stanford lost two games in a row for the first time since just two seasons ago, when the Cardinal suffered back-to-back losses at Arizona and Arizona State on Feb. 5 & 7, 2004 (Stanford was ranked No. 7 at the time). Stanford has not lost back-to-back games twice in a season since 2000-01, when the Cardinal lost at least two games in a row three times.

STREAK STATS...

After Stanford lost back-to-back games in December, the Cardinal rebounded with a seven-game win streak, its longest of the season, during which time **Candice Wiggins** averaged 26.9 points per game -- with four games of 30 points or more. **Brooke Smith** averaged 19.1 points and 8.7 rebounds per game during the stretch and **Rosalyn Gold-Onwude** contributed 5.1 assists per game. **Krista Rappahahn** knocked down 3.7 threes per contest and **Jillian Harmon** added 10.1 points and 5.9 rebounds per game.

MAPLES MAGIC...

Tara VanDerveer's teams have compiled a 272-29 (.904) record at home during her tenure. The Cardinal is 169-11 all-time against Pac-10 foes at home. Stanford has won 68 of its last 72 games at Maples and 11-straight since the Tennessee loss on Dec. 4, 2005. With the 78-47 win over Washington State on Feb. 25, Stanford improved its conference home win streak to 46 games. Stanford's last conference loss in Maples was on March 1, 2001, when USC posted a 62-59 victory over the Cardinal. No member of the current Stanford team has ever lost a conference game in Maples.

CONFERENCE CHATTER...

On March 2, **Candice Wiggins** was named the 2005-06 Pacific-10 Conference Women's Basketball Player of the Year and Tara VanDerveer was voted the Pac-10 Coach of the Year. Wiggins is just the sixth player to receive two Pac-10 Player of the Year awards, and the fifth to receive the honor in consecutive seasons. This is VanDerveer's eighth honor as Pac-10 Coach of the Year and second-straight. Brooke Smith was selected to the All-Pac-10 team, her second All-Conference selection in as many seasons with the Cardinal. Jillian Harmon was named to the All-Freshman team, the 21st Cardinal to claim rookie honors, and third consecutive. And Rosalyn Gold-Onwude was an honorable mention selection to the All-Freshman squad.

KATRINA ASSIST...

Assistant coach Charmin Smith is spearheading a year-long fund-raiser by the Stanford Women's Basketball team this year, as the program collects pledges for every Stanford assist in order to help the Peninsula Habitat, our local chapter of Habitat for Humanity International, build houses for Operation Home Delivery, a tremendous nationwide effort, that will shipped new homes to the Hurricane Katrina-devastated Gulf Coast area. The California Golden Bears are also launching a Katrina Assist program. More information and pledge forms can be found at GoStanford.com.

LOOKING AHEAD...

Next season, the Cardinal will add four freshmen to its roster, as Jayne Appel, Michelle Harrison, JJ Hones and Melanie Murphy all signed a National Letter of Intent in November. Scout.com has ranked the class No. 3 in the nation, while Blue Star ranks the group at No. 4. Appel and Harrison were both selected for the 2006 McDonald's All-American High School girls' basketball team on Feb. 22. Harrison is the first Utah girl to receive the honor. The quartet will arrive on The Farm in 2006 and will make an immediate impact:
