The Stanford women's gymnastics team returns to the NCAA Championships for the fifth time in six years and competes in the nationals for the 12th time overall. Stanford is seeded 10th among 12 teams at the event and will open in its six-team semifinals session on Friday morning at The Arena at Gwinnett Center in Duluth, Ga. The top three teams in each of the two sessions advance to Saturday's Super Six, which determines the national champion. Stanford is seeking a sixth appearance in the finals, all since 2002.

Stanford Storylines

- **Born Leader:** Jenny Peter, a senior captain, helped organize an education program in the U.S. Virgin Islands last summer that brought together high school students from all over the territory for three weeks and empowered them to become leaders who make positive changes in their communities.
- **Czech Mate:** Nicole Pechanec's parents emigrated from Czechoslovakia when it was still under communist rule (as a young gymnast, her mother, Yveta, competed against Nadia Comeneci). Though she grew up in New Jersey, Nicole moved to the Czech Republic at age 16 and lived on her own while training and competing for the Czech national team.
- **Comeback Story:** Amanda Spinner, a sophomore captain, missed the past two years with injuries, but returned to action this year and, in an amazing comeback story, won the regional title on the balance beam.
- **Family Ties:** Ashley Morgan is the daughter of Hall of Fame baseball player Joe Morgan and comes from the same hometown (Danville, Calif.) and the same gym (Bay Aerials) as her longtime friend Spinner. Morgan is the Pac-12 floor champion.
- **Hockey History:** Alyssa Brown, a senior captain, was a hockey player for a number of years while growing up in Canada and is a big fan of the NHL's Toronto Maple Leafs. She suffered a shoulder injury in the off-season and it appeared might not be able to compete this season. However, she worked her way back into three events -- scoring a 9.90 at regionals in only her second routine this season, and won the regional crown on vault.
- **Elite Champion:** Ivana Hong was a 2009 U.S. senior national champion and national team veteran, is excelling in her first collegiate season, winning a Pac-12 title on vault.

The Fab Five

Stanford coach Kristen Smyth has placed a great deal of responsibility upon her five-member freshman class -- one that figures to be one of the best in school history. The class is comprised of two-time U.S. senior national champion and 2012 Pac-12 vault champion **Ivana Hong**, former U.S. national team member **Samantha Shapiro**, 2008 British Olympian **Rebecca Wing**, and two-time Junior Olympic national qualifiers **Alex Archer** and **Pauline Hanset**. Hong was limited by injuries early, but now is in the lineup in multiple events. Shapiro has largely competed in one as she overcomes injuries of her own. All have made an impact in the lineup. Shapiro has scored 9.875s on bars and vault, Hong has scored 9.9's on vault and beam, Wing should perform at leadoff in two events at nationals. Hanset has scored six 9.85's or higher on floor, and Archer has been in the vault lineup in four meets.

NCAA Regional Review

Stanford finished second at the NCAA Champaign (Ill.) Regional, scoring 196.675 points to edge host Illinois (195.725) for the final qualifying spot, behind Oklahoma (197.025). Three Cardinal individual champions were crowned: senior **Alyssa Brown** on vault (9.900), senior **Nicole Pechanec** on the uneven bars (9.925), and sophomore **Amanda Spinner**, who finished in a four-way tie on the balance beam (9.900). The titles were the first of any kind on the collegiate level for each.

Super Six Experience

Stanford has four gymnasts who were part of the lineups that competed in the 2010 NCAA Super Six finals in Gainesville, Fla., on the Cardinal's fourth-place team. They are: **Alyssa Brown, Ashley Morgan, Nicole Pechanec, and Jenny Peter.**

Stanford NCAA Championship Facts

- Team is competing in its 12th NCAA Championship meet.
- Has reached the Super Six five times.
- Most recent Super Six appearance was 2010 (fourth place).
- All of team's Super Six appearances have come since 2002.
- The program's high finish has been third in 2004 and 2008.
- Team's highest NCAA score was 197.200 in 2007 prelims.
- Highest Super Six score was 197.125 in 2004 (third place).
- There have been two individual NCAA champions from Stanford.
- **Larissa Fontaine** tied for first on vault in 1998 (9.8625).
- Carly Janiga won the bars in 2010 in Gainesville, Fla.
- Her score of 9.9375 is the program's highest in NCAA competition.
- Program has 15 first-team All-Americans in its history.
- Those individuals totaled 49 first-team All-America honors.
- Current assistant coach **Tabitha Yim** has the most first-team All-America honors in school history, with 13 from 2005-08.
- The highest all-around finish was **Carly Janiga's** third in 2010.
- Stanford has had 20 All-Americans total.

Stanford vs. Other NCAA Competitors:

The following are results of Stanford's most recent meetings with teams from Session I:

- **UCLA:** Stanford and UCLA faced each other twice this season, with the Bruins winning both times, most recently at the Pac-12 Championships in Salt Lake City on March 24 when the Bruins (197.425) won and the Cardinal fell from first to fourth on the final rotation (196.825). On Feb. 5 at UCLA, Stanford lost the dual meet, 197.250-196.450 in Westwood. Stanford has a 12-10 series advantage over UCLA since 2006.
- **Oklahoma:** The Sooners (197.025) and Stanford (196.675) finished 1-2 at the six-team NCAA Champaign (Ill.) Regional on April 7.
- **Nebraska:** Stanford (196.800) was first, Michigan (196.500) second and Nebraska (195.400) third in a tri-meet in Ann Arbor, Mich., on Feb. 13, 2011.
- **Utah:** The Pac-12's newest member has played host to the Cardinal twice this season, winning a dual meet (196.300-196.100) on Feb. 24 and finishing second at the conference championships (197.375) to Stanford's fourth (196.925) on March 24.
- **LSU:** The third-place Tigers (196.300) edged Stanford (196.225) for the final qualifying spot in Session I of the 2009 NCAA team preliminaries in Lincoln, Neb.

The following are results of Stanford's most recent meetings with teams from Session II:

- **Florida:** Stanford finished fourth (197.100) to the Gators fifth (197.000) at the Super Six in Gainesville, Fla., on April 23, 2010.
- **Alabama:** The Crimson Tide (197.225) edged Stanford (197.100) for third place at the 2010 Super Six in Gainesville, Fla.
- **Georgia:** In the 2010 season opener (Jan. 9), Georgia (195.150) opened the post-Suzanne Yoculan era with a dual-meet victory in Athens, Ga., over the Cardinal (195.050).
- **Arkansas:** Stanford (196.300) finished third in Session II at the 2010 NCAA team preliminaries ahead of fifth-place Arkansas (195.600) to advance to the Super Six in Gainesville, Fla.
- **Oregon State:** The Beavers beat Stanford in both matchups this season. The first came in a dual meet in Corvallis, Ore., 196.800-194.525, on Jan. 27. The next came at the Pac-12 Championships in Salt Lake City on March 24 when Oregon State finished third (197.025) to Stanford's fourth (196.825).
- **Ohio State:** The Buckeyes (195.350) and Stanford (195.225) both finished out of qualifying position at the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional on April 2, 2011, with Ohio State third and Stanford fourth.

International Experience

- **Nicole Pechanec:** Competed in three World Championships and two European Championships for the Czech Republic.
- **Samantha Shapiro:** Competed for the U.S. senior national team from 2009-11; won three U.S. junior national championships.
- **Rebecca Wing:** Competed for Great Britain in the 2008 Olympics; two Worlds and two European Championships.

Meet recaps

NorCal Quad Meet

STANFORD -- A pair of 9.9 scores, by junior Ashley Morgan (floor) and senior Nicole Pechanec (bars), highlighted Stanford's season-opening victories over San Jose State, Sacramento State, and UC Davis, before a packed Burnham Pavilion.

Washington dual meet

STANFORD -- Stanford trailed 98.075-97.900 after the first two rotations, but Ashley Morgan's 9.900 and freshman Rebecca Wing's 9.875 helped propel the Cardinal to a lead it would not relinquish. In all, Stanford's top four beam scores of the early season all came on in the 195.925-195.725 victory at Burnham Pavilion.

Oregon State dual meet

CORVALLIS, Ore. -- Alyssa Brown or Nicole Dayton each earned Stanford's highest scores of the season, on the beam and vault, respectively, in the Cardinal's 196.800-194.525 loss to Oregon State. Brown scored a winning 9.925 and Dayton a second-place 9.90.

UCLA dual meet

LOS ANGELES -- Nicole Pechanec tied for first in floor exercise (9.90) and scored her career-high in the all-around (39.325) to help Stanford to its season-high score to that point in a 197.250-196.450 loss at UCLA.

Cal dual meet

BERKELEY, Calif. -- Stanford freshmen Ivana Hong and Pauline Hanset earned their first collegiate victories to lead the Cardinal past Cal for the 25th consecutive time, with a 196.175-194.725 victory at Haas Pavilion. Hong tied for first on beam (9.90) and Hanset won floor (9.85).

Metroplex Challenge

FORT WORTH, Texas -- Ashley Morgan won the uneven bars (9.875) and tied with teammate Nicole Pechanec to win the floor exercise, each with a 9.925 - a score reached only twice all season in all events for the Cardinal to that point in the season.

Utah dual meet

SALT LAKE CITY -- Stanford sophomore Amanda Spinner, out more than two years with a knee injury, earned her first collegiate victory to highlight Stanford's performance in a 196.300-196.100 loss to No. 5 Utah before 14,756 at the Huntsman Center.

Stanford Tri-Meet

STANFORD -- Nicole Pechanec's 9.925 on bars was one of five Stanford scores of 9.9 or above during a meet in which the Cardinal won every event, while beating Arizona and Cal. The Cardinal extended its' unbeaten streak against Pac-12 opponents at Burnham Pavilion to 34.

Arizona State dual meet

TEMPE, Ariz. -- Alyssa Brown led a Stanford trio of 9.9 scores on the balance beam to help the Cardinal to a 196.475-194.975 regular-season finale victory at Arizona State

Pacific-12 Conference Championships

SALT LAKE CITY -- Stanford scored team season highs on beam, floor, and vault to take the lead going into the final rotation, but struggled on the uneven bars to fall to fourth. Freshman Ivana Hong won the vault with a 9.95 and Ashley Morgan scored the same, to win her second consecutive conference floor title.

NCAA Champaign Regional

CHAMPAIGN, Ill. -- Stanford got first-ever regional championships from Alyssa Brown on vault (9.90), Nicole Pechanec on bars (9.925), and Amanda Spinner on beam (9.90) to finish second and advance to the NCAA Championships for the fifth time in six years.

Kristen Smyth has coached the Stanford women's gymnastics team to unprecedented success during her 11 seasons.

- Of Stanford's 85 All-America honors, 64 have come in Smyth's tenure.
- There have been 68 Scholastic All-American honors in that span.
- Smyth has coached the Cardinal into the NCAA Super Six finals five times -- Stanford had never advanced that far before -- and finished among the top-four three times.
- Of Stanford's eight NCAA top-10 finishes, Smyth has coached the team to seven of them.
- Smyth, in her 11th year, is the longest tenured and winningest coach in the history of the 35-year-old program.
- Smyth has a 174-48-1 record at Stanford and, this year, coached the team to a 14-6 record.
- Smyth's gymnasts have won 27 individual regional titles, 24 Pac-10 titles, four team regional championships and three conference titles.

In 2011, the Cardinal qualified for the NCAA regionals for the 29th consecutive season and earned its fifth NCAA Championships berth in six years. It marks Stanford's eighth national-championship appearance under Smyth. No other Stanford coach had reached the NCAA's more than twice.

In an example of the team's strength, five different Stanford gymnasts have won conference or regional titles this season. The list includes Pac-12 champions Ivana Hong and Ashley Morgan, and NCAA Champaign Regional champs Alyssa Brown, Nicole Pechanec, and Amanda Spinner.

In addition, three Stanford gymnasts were named to the All-Pac-12 team.

Smyth has coached a national champion -- Carly Janiga on bars in 2010. In fact, Stanford's six most decorated gymnasts, according to All-America honors, were all coached by Smyth, a four-time conference Coach of the Year.

Chris Swircek is in his ninth season and third as associate head coach. His primary coaching responsibilities are vault and uneven bars. Swircek also coordinates team travel, oversees the club and summer camp programs, and assists with recruiting.

The uneven bars have been a strength for Stanford under Swircek, with six Pac-12 champions, seven NCAA Regional champs, 13 All-America honors, and one national champion -- 2010 winner Carly Janiga.

In addition, Stanford has had seven All-Americans and six regional champions on vault in that span.

Swircek has helped coach Stanford athletes to 22 All-America honors (16 first team) in bars and on vault, and coached Ivana Hong to the 2012 Pac-12 vault title, Alyssa Brown to the regional vault title, and Nicole Pechanec to the 2012 regional bars title. In 2010, Shelley Alexander won regional titles in each event.



Tabitha Yim

Tabitha Yim, the most decorated gymnast in Stanford history, is in her second season as a Cardinal assistant coach.

Yim was a 14-time All-American at Stanford from 2005-08, earning the most All-America honors in school history, including 13 first-team selections. She placed among the top 10 in the NCAA all-around competition all four years and twice won Pacific-10 Conference and NCAA regional all-around titles. No one in Stanford history has more NCAA top-10 finishes than Yim, who had 11.

Yim's versatility was her strength. She won two regional titles and one Pac-10 championship on the balance beam, was a two-time regional uneven bars champion, and twice placed third in floor exercise at the NCAA Championships.

A native of Irvine, Calif., Yim competed for the United States national team that placed third at the 2001 world championships. During her collegiate career, she led Stanford to two Pac-10 titles, one regional championship, and two NCAA Super Six appearances.

Before returning to Stanford, Yim was involved in Teach for America, and taught ninth-grade science at Animo Ralph Bunche Charter High School in south Los Angeles.
