### NCAA Women's Tennis Championships

May 20-23 • University of Georgia • Athens, Ga.

### STANFORD SEASON UPDATE:

- \* - No. 2-seeded Stanford advanced to the NCAA Tournament Round of 16 after consecutive shutouts over Quinnipiac (4-0) and No. 26 Michigan (4-0) in first- and second-round action at Taube Tennis Center.
- \* - No. 1 Stanford claimed its 17th-straight Pacific-10 Conference title after tallying a perfect 8-0 league record ... The Cardinal remain the top team in the nation with an unblemished 25-0 overall record ... Stanford has been ranked No. 1 by the ITA for 12-straight weeks.
- \* - Stanford's last perfect season was in 2001, head coach Lele Forood's first year at the Cardinal helm ... Stanford has posted nine unblemished season's in its history.
- \* - The Cardinal have tallied 16 shutouts this year.
- \* - Two regulars in Stanford's lineup stand undefeated in dual singles action: senior Lauren Barnikow (23-0) and freshman Theresa Logar (24-0).
- \* - Stanford has won 166-of-172 matches over the past six seasons.

### NCAA TOURNAMENT:

- \* - The Cardinal have claimed 12 all-time NCAA titles and 13 collegiate titles (1982 was the first year of the NCAA Tournament) ... Stanford last won the Tournament in 2002 ... Last season, the Cardinal took second place after falling to Florida 4-3.
- \* - The Cardinal boast an 82-11 (.882) all-time Tournament record.
- \* - Stanford has competed in post-season action for the past 30 years ... The Cardinal have earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament in every year of the Tournament's 23-year existence.
- \* - Stanford has advanced to the final match in 17 of its last 22 NCAA Championship appearances.
- \* - Head coach Lele Forood has led Stanford to two national titles and one runner-up finish during her three-year tenure with the Cardinal.
- \* - Stanford athletes have tallied 11 singles and four doubles NCAA titles

# Head Coach Lele Forood

*1976 Stanford All-American*

*1997 ITA National Assistant Coach of the Year*

Head women's tennis coach Lele Forood, the 2004 Pacific-10 Conference Coach of the Year, entered her fourth year at Stanford after a three-season tenure that boasts two NCAA team titles and one runner-up finish. After serving as an assistant and associate head coach at Stanford for 13 years, Forood has made the most of her time with the Cardinal women's tennis team, guiding them to a 107-3 record.

This season, the top-ranked Cardinal have tallied a perfect 25-0 record, while notching its 17th-straight Pac-10 title. Stanford makes its 23rd consecutive appearance in the NCAA Tournament and boasts the Pac-10 Doubles Team of the Year for the second-straight season in Lauren Barnikow and Erin Burdette. Forood was named the league's coach of the year for her efforts with the Cardinal this season.

Last season, Forood led the Cardinal to a 25-2 record overall, a second-place finish at the NCAA Tournament and a Pac-10 title. Cardinal freshman Amber Liu was crowned the 2003 NCAA Singles Champion.

In Forood's second year, the Cardinal capped off a 6-0 run in the NCAA Tournament with a 4-1 victory over top-ranked Florida in the title match. Forood guided Stanford, which won its 12th NCAA Team Championship in the 22-year history of the event, to a 27-1 overall record and a Pac-10 Championship.

Forood became the first female head coach to win the NCAA team title in 2001. The championship was the first for Forood, who was an assistant coach for five national title runs from 1989-1991 and in 1997 and 1999. She guided the Cardinal to a 30-0 mark in her first complete season at the helm, as well as the 2000 Pac-10 Championship and a final No. 1 ranking. That year marked the ninth perfect season and first in over 10 years.

Forood replaced one of Stanford's all-time great coaches in Frank Brennan, who retired in June 2000 after 21 years and 10 national championships.

She was an assistant coach for 10 years before being promoted to associate head coach in March of 2000. In 1997, Forood's efforts in helping lead the Cardinal to the NCAA title were recognized as she was named the Division I National Assistant Coach of the Year by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association.

An All-American at Stanford 1976, the first year they started the All-American accolades, Forood was a National Collegiate singles finalist as a freshman and a semifinalist during her sophomore campaign. Competing internationally, she captured the gold medal in both singles and doubles at the 1975 Pan American Games. She was also the 1975 national amateur singles and doubles champion. Forood was ranked as high as 30th on the women's professional tour, and she had an impressive victory over Wimbledon Champion and second-seed Virginia Wade at the 1977 U.S. Open. At the 1976 U.S. Open, Forood teamed with Rachel Giscafre to reach the doubles semifinals.

Forood was a member of the Board of Women's Tennis Associates from 1979-1987 and served as its secretary-treasurer from 1983-87. She has been extremely active in promoting WTA events, and was the recipient of the prestigious WTA Player Service Award in 1983. After the tour and before coming back to Stanford, she promoted the first professional women's tour event in France from 1986-1988 at Strasbourg.

A native of Fort Lauderdale, Fla., Forood was a member of Stanford's class of 1978, graduating with a degree in sociology.

Senior • 5-9 • Cincinnati, Ohio (Anderson HS)

**2003-04 (Senior):** Ranked No. 60 in ITA singles rankings and No. 56 in the doubles rankings with partner Anne Yelsey ... Has posted a 24-7 singles record this season, including an 18-2 dual record primarily at the No. 6 spot ... Boasts a 24-4 doubles record with Yelsey ... Went 14-4 vs. Pac-10 opponents ... Downed Debra Streifler of Michigan in NCAA Second Round 6-2, 6-3 to clinch the Cardinal victory ... Defeated No. 80 Carine Ver Meulen of USC (6-2, 6-7, 6-3) in first round of Pac-10 Individual Tournament ... Advanced to the doubles quarterfinals with Yelsey at Pac-10 Tournament ... Tallied a 4-0 record to help Stanford to National Team Indoors title ... Defeated No. 10 Anca Dumitrescu of Florida State in the round of 32 at the Riviera/ITA All-American 6-2, 6-4 ... Advanced to the quarterfinals of the ITA Northwest Regionals at Stanford in October with wins over Fresno State's Kathrin Winterhalter (6-4, 6-2), Cal Poly's Sheila Lewis (6-2, 7-5) and No. 9 Dea Sumantri of Washington (7-5, 4-5 ret.).
