Head Coach JR Payne

JR Payne is in her second season as head coach at Santa Clara in 2015-16.

Payne led the Broncos to 10 wins and five WCC victories while advancing to the second round of the WCC Tournament in her first season in 2014-15. Santa Clara pulled an upset of LSU, the first win for Santa Clara against an SEC team since a 58-53 win on Dec. 14, 1996 vs. Mississippi at the Wahine Invitational in Honolulu, Hawaii.

Perviously Payne had been the head coach at Southern Utah for five seasons, leading the team to a school-record 23 wins in 2013-14 and advancing to the national postseason for the first time in school history. Prior to that, Payne was an assistant coach on the Mission campus in 2008-09. An All-WCC point guard who graduated from Saint Mary's in 1999, Payne has also served as an assistant coach at Boise State and Gonzaga.

During her 14-year career as a women's college basketball coach, she has been a part of four conference championships and five post-season appearances as well as an undefeated league season. She has helped coach two All-Americans, three conference players of the year, 32 all-conference players and 31 all-academic honorees.

THE BRONCOS

Santa Clara (1-2) is shooting 35.6% (57-160) from the field during the first three games of the season. The Broncos have scored an average of 56.3 points per game and grabbed 39.7 rebounds per game. They have already collected 36 steals as a team.

Savanna Hanson leads the team with 10.7 ppg on 45.8% (11-24) shooting from the field. She adds 4.3 rpg and 2.0 spg. Devin Hudson averages 8.7 ppg on 66.7% (12-18) from the floor and leads the Broncos with 6.3 rpg. Taylor Berry is tops on Santa Clara with eight steals while adding 8.3 ppg and 2.7 rpg.

THE CARDINAL

Stanford (3-0) topped George Washington 84-63 on Saturday. In the first three games the Cardinal have shot 41.5% (80-193) from the field and 37.3% (22-59) from beyond the arc. They have added 14.7 apg and outscored opponents 223-156.

Erica McCall is averaging a double-double with 17.0 ppg and 11.3 rpg. Her five steals and five blocks are also tops on the team. Lili Thompson is scoring 17.3 ppg to lead the team and leads the Cardinal with eight threes made. Briana Roberson is averaging a team-best 4.0 apg to go with 7.3 ppg and 3.0 rpg.

THE FIRST WIN OF THE YEAR

In the home opener, Santa Clara women's basketball beat Air Force by a final of 68-34 on Saturday afternoon. The Broncos were able to pull away in the second quarter behind a 12-0 run to pick up their first win of the year.

Freshman Savanna Hanson scored a game-high 15 points on 5 of 8 shooting from the field and was a perfect 5 of 5 from the charity stripe. She added seven rebounds. Taylor Berry scored 11 with five boards and five steals while Marie Bertholdt scored eight.

Air Force (0-3) was led by eight points from Cortney Porter. She added four assists and two rebounds as well. Dee Bennett chipped in six points and six boards.

The Bronco defense limited Air Force to 22.0% (9-41) shooting from the field and forced 30 turnovers.

NOTRE DAME DE NAMUR EXHIBITON

The Broncos handled the Argonauts 90-50 in their first exhibition game. Junior Lori Parkinson led all scorers with 21 points and added six boards to with four blocks and four steals.

Taylor Berry scored 18 points and had four steals while sophomore forward Morgan McGwire led Santa Clara with nine rebounds and scored 15 points. Newcomer Kyla Martin had five assists and freshman guard Savanna Hanson scored 12 points to go along with three steals and two assists.

The Bronco defense forced 33 Gator turnovers while picking up 21 steals.

SAN FRANCISCO STATE EXHIBITION

Against the Gators Santa Clara came away with a 71-42 victory. Forward Marie Bertholdt, one of four players in double figures, scored a game-high 18 points and grabbed seven rebounds.

Forward Morgan McGwire posted 13 points and freshman guard Savanna Hanson added 12 and eight assists for the Broncos who pulled away from the Gators late in the third quarter. Santa Clara dominated in the paint, holding a 50-32 edge in rebounds and connecting on 21 of 31 free throws, including 8 of 10 by Bertholdt who was a perfect 5-for-5 from the floor.

Lori Parkinson chipped in 10 points and had all three of Santa Clara's blocks. Taylor Berry had nine points and a gamehigh nine steals as the Broncos forced the Gators into 32 turnovers.
