ABOUT THE BUFFS: Colorado is 5-9 overall and 0-3 in Pac-12 play after dropping at 64-35 decision at No. 21 California on Friday, Jan. 8. The Buffaloes will look to snap a four-game losing skid and earn its first conference win of the season as they are set to play Stanford in their second of four straight road contests.

On offense, the Buffaloes are averaging 68.0 points per game while shooting 41.7 percent from the field. Colorado is shooting 76.2 percent at the free throw line, 15th in the nation and third in the Pac-12 Conference. The team has also found success shooting from long distance as CU ranks 20th in the country and second among Pac-12 teams in 3-point field goal percentage, connecting on 37.1 percent of its shots behind the arc.

Defensively, Colorado has allowed 69.5 points per game on 40.6 percent from the field. The Buffaloes average 38.4 rebounds, 26.9 defensive boards, and are fifth in the Pac-12 with 4.7 blocked shots per game.

Senior **Jamee Swan** missed her first game of her collegiate career at California on Friday due to a back injury. The team's top scorer and rebounder, Swan is averaging 15.4 points and 7.8 rebounds while hitting 49.7 percent from the field and 71.9 percent from the free throw line. Swan has also recorded a team-leading 25 blocks on the season and three double-doubles.

Swan ranks 11th in the Pac-12 in scoring, eighth in field goal percentage, 12th in overall rebounding, is ninth with 5.6 defensive rebounds per game, 11th with 2.2 offensive rebounds a game and is fourth in blocked shots (1.9 bpg).

Freshman **Kennedy Leonard** has made a significant impact for the Buffaloes in her debut season. She enters the game as Colorado's second highest scorer, averaging 12.9 points per game and has also dished out a team-leading 68 assists, averaging 4.9 in each contest.

On the Pac-12 leaderboard, Leonard is 18th in scoring, seventh in assists, and 13th in assist/turnover ratio (1.4).

Guard/forward **Haley Smith** is having a strong junior campaign, averaging 9.8 points per game (29th in the Pac-12) and is second on the team with 5.1 rebounds. She has been one of Colorado's most accurate shooters from the field with at 46.21 percent and has gone 21-of-24 (.875) from the free-throw line.

Junior wing **Lauren Huggins** is averaging 8.6 points per game and is third on the team in 3-point shooting (minimum 10 attempts), connecting on 31-of-83 from long range for a 37.3 field goal percentage from behind the arc. Huggins hit four of her five 3-pointers against Loyola Marymount and four of eight against Presbyterian, tying a career-high with 16 points in both contests to help the Buffs earn two victories. The Littleton, Colo. native is fourth in the conference in 3-point field goals made as she averages 2.2 per game and 15th in 3-point field goal percentage.

Freshman **Alexis Robinson** has earned a place in the starting line up recently, as she has made back-to-back starts after providing a nice spark off the bench in the previous four consecutive games. The Ashland, Ky. native is averaging 7.8 points, 3.9 rebounds and 3.0 assists in 25 minutes per game. She is shooting 43.5 percent from the 3-point line, second best on the team and has connected on 39.6 percent of her shots from the field. Robinson had one of her best offensive performances of her young career against UMass when she scored a personal-best 21 points and her best defensive performance came in the Buffs' Pac-12 opener when she held the Huskies' Kelsey Plum to a season low 18 points, 10 below her nation leading average of 28.1 per game. Robinson ranks 14th in the Pac-12 in assists and 14th in assist/turnover ratio (1.4).

ABOUT STANFORD: The Stanford Cardinal are 12-3 overall and 2-1 in the Pac-12 after defeating Utah, 72-52 on Friday. The Cardinal, ranked No. 9 in the AP poll and 13 in the USA Today Sports WBCA poll, have won six of their last seven games. They are averaging 70.5 points per game and shooting 42.9 percent from the field. Stanford allows 52.6 points per game and owns the top defense in terms of opponent field goal percentage, holding teams to 30.4 percent from the field.

A pair of Cardinal are averaging double-figures in scoring with junior guard Lili Thompson leading Stanford and is 10th in the Pac-12 at 15.5 points per game. Junior forward Erica McCall is the Cardinal's other double-digit scorer and top rebounder, tallying 12.9 points and 9.4 rebounds per game. She ranks fifth in the Pac-12 in rebounding and is third in blocked shots, averaging 2.1 on the season. Collectively, the Cardinal block 6.4 shots per game as they rank second in the Pac-12 in that category.

Tara VanDerveer is in her 30th season at Stanford with a record of 812-169 and owns a 964-220 career mark over 36-plus years.

THE SERIES: This will be the 18th meeting between Colorado and Stanford with the Cardinal holding an 13-4 advantage in the series. Stanford has won the last eight, all since Colorado joined the Pac-12 for the 2011-12 season. The Cardinal won the only meeting last season, a 62-55 decision in Stanford on Jan. 3, 2015. Colorado's last win over Stanford came in 2002 when the Buffs defeated the Cardinal, 62-59, in the NCAA Regional Semifinal in Boise, Idaho. Colorado will be looking for its first win at Maples Pavilion in its eighth attempt.

Linda Lappe is 0-8 against Stanford as a head coach. Tara VanDeveer is 13-4 against Colorado as a head coach.

WHAT'S NEXT?: The Buffaloes travel to the Valley of the Sun and will face No. 14/14 Arizona State on Friday, Jan. 15. Then CU closes out its road trip at Arizona on Sunday, Jan. 17, which will be televised on the Pac-12 Networks.

SWAN REACHES 1,000: Senior Jamee Swan became the 28th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points on Saturday, Dec. 19 as the Buffaloes defeated Presbyterian 72-60 at the Coors Events Center. She scored her 1,000th career point on a layup with 2:55 remaining in the third quarter and finished the game with 16 points.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE RARITY: Freshman **Kennedy Leonard** recorded her first career double-double with 15 points and a career-high 10 assists against then-No. 13 Kentucky on Nov. 22 in Lexington, becoming just the fifth player in school history to earn a points-assists double-double.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Senior Jamee Swan has recorded a double-digit scoring effort in 12 of 13 games played this season to lead the Buffs offensively as she is averaging 15.4 points. Swan also has a team-leading three double-doubles this season. She tallied her first (13 points, 10 rebounds) against Northern Colorado on Nov. 19., and then had a double-double in back-to-back games, against Presbyterian on Dec. 19 (16 points 11 rebounds), allowing her to take over sole possession for 12th place on the all-time double-doubles list and her third came at Wyoming (28 points, 13 rebounds) on Dec. 21. Swan has 13 double-doubles in her career. Freshman Kennedy Leonard has 10 double-digit scoring performances and juniors Haley Smith and Lauren Huggins have six. Freshman Alexis Robinson has recorded five and junior Zoe Beard-Fails along with sophomore Brecca Thomas have each tallied a pair of 10+ scoring games.

RECORD BOOK WATCH: Senior Jamee Swan and junior Lauren Huggins continue to climb the record books this season. Swan, who recorded 11 rebounds against Presbyterian (Dec. 19) in the Buffs' non-conference home finale moved into 14th place all-time, passing Randie Wirt (2000-04). Averaging a team-high 15.4 rebounds per game, Swan is on pace to continue to move up the all-time list before season's end as she only needs eight rebounds to claim 13 place

Nothing comes easy once conference play begins and Colorado had the envious task of opening with the 15th ranked team in the country on their home court, a place the Buffaloes have never won. The final result still favored the home team, but Colorado proved to be a worthy early opponent for the defending league champions and the Buffaloes came away with plenty of reasons to feel good about moving forward.

Colorado completely erased an 11-point second half deficit, but a late 8-0 run gave Stanford enough of a cushion to hold on for a 62-55 Saturday night at Maples Pavilion in the Pac-12 Conference opener for both teams. James Swan had her second consecutive double-double leading the Buffaloes with 12 points and a game-high 10 rebounds. Colorado (7-5, 0-1) had several bright moments defensively. The Buffaloes forced 16 turnovers, several coming on shot clock violations after 30 seconds of intense defense. Colorado played even – and at times better than the Cardinal - on the boards for most of the game, although Stanford would end up with a slight overall edge (37-35).

But one thing the Buffaloes couldn't stop was the backcourt combination of Amber Orrange and Lili Thompson. The Cardinal duo combined for 43 of Stanford's 62 points, hitting both the outside shot and getting into the paint as well. Orrange had a game-high 26 points on 10-of-16 shooting with a pair of 3-pointers. Thompson had 17 points making 7-of-12.

Colorado set the tone defensively early as Stanford's first two possessions ended in a blocked shot and a shot clock violation as the Buffaloes held an early 5-2 lead. Thompson opt going for the Cardinal (9-4, 1-0) who scored seven straight or a four point advantage. Swan scored four in a row for the Buffaloes who tied the game at 11-11, but she picked up her second foul less than 10 minutes in. Zoe Beard-Fails, making her third start of the season also got into foul trouble, forcing the Buffaloes deep into their frontcourt bench. San Francisco native Zoe Correal, who had played just 10 minutes in the previous four games, put in some key minutes. She scored all of her career-best six points, during a seven minute stretch in the first half.

Most importantly, Correal's minutes came at a time that halted Stanford's biggest run. Orrange had scored five points during a 9-0 run that gave the Cardinal a 30-19 lead. Stanford was red hot early, but cooled off at the right time. The Cardinal scored just two points in the final 4:17 and none after Thompson scored from 15-feet out with 3:31 left as Stanford's lead was down to 32-25 at the break.

Shortly after Briana Roberson put Stanford back into a double-digit lead at 42-31 with a 3-pointer, the Buffaloes turned it up defensively. Colorado forced seven Stanford turnovers held the Cardinal scoreless over a 4:44 stretch that put the Buffaloes back in the lead. Haley Smith and Swan scored nack-to-back layups to start the run. Lexy Kresl would then score consecutive baskets to bring Ut to within two at 42-40. The comeback was complete when freshman Brecca Thomas hit CU's only 3-pointer of the game, with 10:14 left giving the Buffaloes a 43-42 lead.

But Stanford's Bonnie Samuelson responded immediately with a 3-pointer of her own to put the Cardinal back on top. Samuelson's 3-pointer, her only make on six tries, sparked an 8-0 run as the Cardinal retook the lead 50-43. Swan pulled Colorado back to four at 51-47, but the Buffaloes missed their next three shots and Stanford reclaimed a double-digit lead at 57-47

Colorado clamped down for one final time. Leading scorer Jen Reese who had been silent for most of the game scored six of her 10 points in the final minutes with a long jumper bringing the Buffaloes to within four at 57-53 with just over a minute remaining. But the Buffaloes couldn't draw any closer as Orrange scored her 10th bucket of the game and also hit a free throw in the final seconds.

Swan then moved into fourth place on the all-time blocked shots list after swatting four shots against Washington, leaping Raegan Scott (1993-97). Swan now is six blocks away from moving into the top three on the all-time list.

Huggins, who is shooting .37.3 from behind the arc this season, also moved up in the CU record book after a strong performance in the Pac-12 opener against Washington. She climbed into 11th place on the all-time list for most 3-point field goals, knocking down a trio vs. the Huskies. Huggins moved from 13 to 12 on the list for most 3-point field goal attempts after taking seven shots from long distance at California, passing Alexis Felts (1994-98) in the process. Like Swan, Huggins also is on pace to continue to climb in the record books before her junior year comes to a close as she only needs four more 3-point attempts to take over 11th place.

HIGH FIVES: Three times this season the Buffaloes have finished a game with five players recording at least 10 points. Colorado accomplished this feat most recently against Washington in its Pac-12 opener. Freshman Kennedy Leonard and senior Jamee Swan scored 19 points, freshman Alexis Robinson tallied 13, junior Haley Smith finished with 12 and junior Lauren Huggins chipped in 11 points. The other two times a Buffs' quintet reached this mark was against Northern Arizona and Loyola Marymount.

DOMINANT IN NON-CONFERENCE: The Buffaloes have been dominant in regular season nonconference games under **Linda Lappe**. Colorado is 55-16 in that stretch since the beginning of the 2010-11 season. The Buffaloes have won 48 of their last 60 regular season nonconference contests.

A MILESTONE WIN: Head Coach **Linda Lappe** won her 100th career game at Colorado on Thursday, Nov. 19 as the Buffaloes defeated Northern Colorado 63-41 at the Coors Events Center. Lappe is now 103-78 at the helm for the Buffs and her career head coaching record stands at 153-114 in eight-plus seasons.

RETURN TO 'D': Defense has been a staple to the Colorado program under **Linda Lappe** and for the Buffaloes to be successful in 2015-16, toughness on that side of the court will once again be paramount as the Buffs look to make it a priority once again this year after facing some challenges last season.

Three of Colorado's top four single-season field goal percentage defense totals have come under Lappe's direction. The 2012-13 NCAA Tournament team set the bar with a school-record effort at .350. The 2013-14 season's squad came in with the third-best total at .369 and its total during that same year ranked third on the Pac-12 leaderboard and 34th in the nation.

Two of Colorado's top 10 scoring defense totals have come under Lappe's reign including a school-best 54.5 ppg in 2012-13. Three of CU's top 10 rebounding margins have also come in that time frame, including 2013-14's mark of plus-5.0, the eighth best in team history.

HOME AT THE CEC: Colorado is traditionally tough at home with a 409-146 all-time record at the Coors Events Center (.737). The Buffaloes have won 10 or more games in a season at the CEC in 26 of 37 years. The Buffaloes have enjoyed five undefeated seasons (1980-83, 1992-94) at the CEC. Colorado was 10-7 at Coors in 2014-15.

FOR OPENERS: Colorado improved to 37-5 (.881) in all-time season openers and has won the last 16 straight. The Buffaloes started the season with a home game for the 29th time in 42 seasons. Colorado

is an outstanding 40-2 (.952) all-time in home openers and has never lost its overall season opener when played at home (29-0).

TALENTED GUARD CAYLAO-DO SIGNS NLI: Quinessa Caylao-Do, a talented shooting guard from Tacoma, Wash. has signed a national letter of intent to continue her education and join the University of Colorado women's basketball team next fall, head coach Linda Lappe announced.

"Quinessa is a consummate team player who is a proven winner," Lappe said. "She is a versatile player who can defend, score, handle the ball and pass. We are excited to have her as a part of our buff family!"

The 5 foot, 9-inch shooting guard proved to play a pivotal role in her team's State Tournament run last season. As a junior, she scored

a game-high 18 points as she guided Todd Beamer High School to a program-best third-place finish at the 2015 Class 4A State Girls' Basketball Tournament, after making two straight appearances in the district title game (2013, '14). A consistent contributor on the offensive side of the ball, she finished her junior campaign averaging 13.5 points per game.

Caylao-Do will reunite with Bria Rice, who signed with Colorado last week. Both were teammates at Beamer High School for their first three seasons and have spent time on the same court since middle school. Cayalo-Do will play her senior season at Bellevue High School where she is set to graduate this spring.

"I'm really excited to be joining the Colorado women's basketball team and I'm looking forward to also joining Bria since we won't be playing together this season," said Caylao-Do. "We've been playing together since sixth grade so I'm pumped to be on the same team again."

She called her future Buff teammates "really welcoming" and has been working on becoming faster, more consistent shooter, and hopes that will help translate into Colorado wins.

"I really liked all the coaches and players when I was in Boulder on my official visit," said Caylao-Do. "I felt like I was at home. The campus and facilities were really nice as well."

In addition to her enthusiasm in playing for the black and gold, Caylao-Do is fulfilling her dream to play against some of the best in a challenging Pac-12 Conference.

An All-SPSL South team selection and named to the 2015 State's All-Tournament team, Caylao-Do also has experience competing in the Nike Elite Youth Basketball league as she spent this past summer playing on the Tree of Hope AAU team.

Bria Rice has signed a national letter of intent to play for the University of Colorado women's basketball team and continue her education beginning in 2016-17, head coach Linda Lappe announced on Wednesday, the first day of the NCAA's early signing period.

"Bria is a high energy player who will increase our overall speed and athleticism especially on the defensive end of the floor," said Lappe. "She will give us depth in the guard position and we look for her to compete as a freshman. She has high character and loves to win so she fits in great here at Colorado."

Rice, a 5-foot, 8-inch guard from Federal Way, Wash. is preparing for her senior year at Todd Beamer High School where she helped lead the Titans to a school best third-place finish at the 2015 Class 4A state girls' basketball tournament.

"When I came to Colorado on my official visit, I already felt like I belonged as the team and coaches felt like family," said Rice. "I am looking forward to getting better and using my skills to help the team continue to improve."

The Washington native earned a scout grade of 90 on ESPN.com and is described as a jet-quick floor leader, pesky defender in pressure while flourishing in up-tempo situations.

The high school standout averaged 10.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 4.8 assists and 3.5 steals as a junior and has guided her team to threestraight 20+ win seasons, culminating in an impressive 73-9 record.

Rice refers to her style of play as intense and aggressive, and will look to bring that same approach with her when she steps onto campus next fall.

"The fact that the team pushes each other, I love that," Rice said. "Because if you're not pushing each other you're not making each other better. Not only are they there to encourage each other they are there to make each other better and I'm excited to be on a team that has the same mentality that I do."

Rice has earned numerous accolades during high school. She was voted the 2014-15 SPSL 4A Northwest Division Most Valuable Player, which Rice highlights as the biggest moment of her high school career thus far. Her MVP honors came in the same year she helped Todd Beamer qualify for the state tournament for the first time in school history. She also was named The News Tribune's Girls All-Area Basketball Player of the Year.

In addition to her consistent contributions to the Titans, Rice played AAU for Tree of Hope in the Nike Elite Youth Basketball League, the same team current Buff **Haley Smith** was a member of during her prep career. Rice's team placed second in 2014 and then earned a third place finish in 2015 at Nike Nationals.

BUFFS ON TV: Colorado women's basketball will be televised to a regional or national audience at least 15 times during the regular season, including 14 games on the Pac-12 Networks during league play. This marks the fourth consecutive year the Buffaloes will have double-digit regional or national television appearances.

Colorado made their 2015-16 television debut on Saturday, Dec. 12 when the Buffs hosted former Big-12 opponent Missouri at the Coors Events Center.

Colorado's first four Pac-12 games will be televised on the Pac-12 Networks as will seven of the Buffaloes' nine home conference games. All remaining home games, and conference road games, that aren't televised will be scheduled to be streamed live through Colorado's Pac-12.com video portal.

Entering this season, Colorado has tipped off on 143 national or regional telecasts since the fall of 2001, and 44 since the advent of the Pac-12 Networks in 2012.

BUFFS PICKED NINTH: In what is expected to be one of the most competitive league races in recent memory, Colorado was tabbed to finish ninth in the 2015-16 Pac-12 Conference standings according to the annual coaches preseason poll, announced at Pac-12 Media Day on Oct. 14.

Oregon State was voted the preseason favorite for the first time in the history of the poll, claiming 121 points and 11 first place votes. Stanford was second with 104 overall points. The other first place nod went to Arizona State, selected to finish third overall with 102.

California and UCLA were fourth with 88 points apiece followed by was fourth with 84 points followed by Washington (68), USC (60), Oregon (52), Colorado (39), Washington State (30), Utah (23) and Arizona (17).

In the media's preseason poll, Colorado was also picked ninth with 88 points.

BUFFS HOST FIFTH ANNUAL ONE-ON-ONE EVENT AHEAD OF SEASON TIP OFF: The University of Colorado women's basketball

team welcomed fans to the Coors Events Center on Tuesday evening for its fifth annual One-On-One event.

A favorite among many, the premise of the One-On-One event is to have each student-athlete pair up with a prominent female member of the university's faculty/staff and get to know them outside of a classroom or office setting. The pairs then introduce each other to fans in attendance for the main program.

The campus leaders participating this year included department directors, professors and PhD candidates.

Student-athletes and their presenters first sat down at a team dinner to learn about one another. After the dinner concluded, the public event began with a reception where players, the coaching staff and campus leaders greeted the fans in attendance. Former head coach Ceal Barry, who held a similar event during her tenure, served as the event's emcee and brought each player and presenter to the stage.

BURICH TO MISS SEASON: Freshman Monica Burich will miss the 2015-16 women's basketball season after tearing the ACL in her left knee.

Burich, a 6'2" forward, suffered the injury during a routine practice drill late in October.

A three-sport high school standout from Roseville, Minn., Burich averaged over 18 points per game and nine rebounds as a senior. She finished her prep career with 1,266 points, 830 rebounds, 342 assists and 302 steals and was a two-time Class 4A All-State selection by the Minnesota Girls Basketball Coaches Association.
