THE GAME: The No. 10/12 Oregon State women's basketball team (13-3, 4-1 Pac-12) will remain at home Sunday for a marquee matchup with No. 11/12 Stanford (14-3, 4-1). The game will tip off at 6 p.m.

FOLLOW ALONG: Sunday's game will air live on Pac-12 Network, Pac-12 Oregon and Pac-12 Bay Area. Krista Blunk and Mary Murphy will have the call. Live audio will also be available with Ron Callan across the Beaver Radio Network, including on KEJO 1240 AM in Corvallis and on KPOJ 620 AM in Portland, as well as online at OSUBeavers.com. Live stats for all games can be found on OSUBeavers.com.

WHAT'S COMING UP: Oregon State will hit the road next week, as it heads east for a pair of Rocky-Mountain matchups. The Beavers will start the weekend with a 7 p.m. PT tip at Utah on Friday, and will follow that up with a 2 p.m. PT tip at Colorado on Sunday.

TICKETS: Tickets for every home game this season are available at BeaverTickets.com or by calling 800-GOBEAVS. Eight home games remain on Oregon State's 2015-16 schedule, including marquee matchups against Stanford and Arizona State.

OREGON STATE QUICK HITTERS:

- Ruth Hamblin, Jamie Weisner and Sydney Wiese have all been named to the Naismith Trophy Early Season Watch List (released Dec. 9). Oregon State is one of three schools in the country to place a trio of players on the list, joining Connecticut and South Carolina.
- Oregon State is currently ranked No. 10 in the WBCA/USA Today Coaches' Poll and No. 12 the Associated Press rankings.
- Oregon State is one of three teams in the nation with three 1,000-point scorers (Hamblin, Weisner, Wiese), joining Connecticut and Southern Illinois.
- The Beavers have been ranked in the top 12 of the AP Poll every week since Dec. 29 of 2014, and have been ranked in the coaches poll every week since April 7, 2014.
- Oregon State has been dominant in its 13 victories this season, holding one of the highest scoring margins in the nation at 19.3 points.
- The Beavers have controlled the glass this season, leading the nation in defensive rebounds per game (33.0) and sitting sixth in rebounding margin (15.1). California is the only team to out-rebound Oregon State in a game this year (1/15).
- Oregon State has also been one of the best shooting teams in the country, hitting 46.0 percent of its field goal attempts.
- The Beavers have seen a big jump in their free-throw percentage this season, shooting 78.4 percent (third in the nation) from the charity stripe through the first 16 games, compared to 68.3 percent last year.
- The Beavers have held 14 of their 16 opponents to under 40 percent shooting from the floor, and have not allowed an opponent to shoot better than 44.6 percent in any game.
- Dec. 21's game against Cal Poly snapped a streak of 41-consecutive games that the four-player combination of Deven Hunter, Ruth Hamblin, Jamie Weisner and Sydney Wiese had started together. The string dated back to the start of the 2014-15 season.

A LOOK AT THE SCHEDULE:

- The Beavers are on the back end of a challenging string of games, entering the final day of a nine-game stretch that has featured five opponents in the top 16 of the RPI (No. 1 Notre Dame, No. 3 Stanford, No. 11 UCLA, No. 13 Tennessee and No. 16 USC).
- Oregon State will be in the national spotlight when it takes on Arizona State on Feb. 1, as it makes an appearance on ESPN2 as part of ESPN's Big Monday coverage. The Beavers will be one of 15 women's teams in the nation to make a Big Monday appearance this season.

LAST TIME OUT:

- The Beavers shot 55.8 percent from the floor while holding California to 33.9 percent shooting to take a 70-48 win Friday at Gill Coliseum.
- Oregon State earned just its second win over Cal since 2006 and its first set of back-to-back wins over the Golden Bears since 2003.
- Cal became the first team to out-rebound the Beavers in a game, holding a 34-31 edge on the boards.
- Oregon State out-scored Cal 30-22 on points in the paint and out-paced the Golden Bears in every quarter.

WITH A WIN:

- Oregon State would snap a streak of 29-straight losses to Stanford, dating back to Jan. 11, 2001.
- The Beavers would earn their first victory over a ranked opponent this season.
- Oregon State would notch its first weekend-sweep of the Bay Area schools since 1994-95.
- The Beavers would win five of their first six Pac-12 games for the second time in school history.

FORTRESS GILL:

- Oregon State is 35-4 in its last 39 games at Gill Coliseum, dating back to the start of the 2013-14 season. Three of those four losses have come to ranked opponents (No. 14 Tennessee, 12/19/15; No. 19 Stanford, 2/26/15; No. 2 Notre Dame, 12/29/13).
- The Beavers are 19-1 in their last 20 Pac-12 home games.
- Oregon State leads the Pac-12 in attendance with an average of 4,288 fans per game. That total is the highest in the conference by far, out-pacing second-place Stanford by 1,231.
- Dec. 19's crowd of 8,223 vs. Tennessee was the second-highest in school history, trailing only the the Beavers' 1996 matchup with Stanford.

SWISH SISTER: Jamie Weisner Quick Hitters

- Is shooting 48.7 percent from the floor, good for eighth in the Pac-12, and the second-highest percentage among guards in the conference.
- Is shooting 92.3 percent from the free-throw line, the third-best percentage in the nation.
- Had a streak of 23-straight made free-throws, spanning over a month (Dec. 2-Jan. 8).
- Should Weisner continue her hot free-throw shooting, she will put herself in contention for the Pac-12 single-season record for free-throw percentage (Kristin Iwanaga, Cal - 93.4 percent in 2004-05; Oregon State record - Mercedes Fox-Griffin - 90 percent in 2008-09). Penn State's Adrienne Squire own the NCAA record at 96.4 percent (2005-06)
- Has gone over 20 points four times this season, and has scored in double-figures in nine-straight games.
- Her 16.6 points per game is good for ninth in the Pac-12 this season.
- Is second in school history with 206 career 3-pointers, trailing only teammate Sydney Wiese.
- All-Pac-12 honors last season.
- Is averaging 6.3 rebounds per game over her last eight games.
- Was All-Pac-12 honorable mention in her freshman and sophomore seasons.
- Was one of the best rebounding guards in the conference a season ago, pulling down 6.2 boards per game.
- Earned ESPNW National Player of the Week honors in January of 2015.
- Brothers Brett (Western Washington) and Michael (Montana) both played college basketball.

CANADIAN HAMMER: Ruth Hamblin quick hitters

- Named a preseason All-American by Lindy's, Athlon and Sporting News
- Made the All-Pac-12 Preseason Team
- Is listed as Lindy's preseason pick for National Defensive Player of the Year.
- Pac-12 Media Player of the Year in 2014-15, and was the conference's consensus Defensive Player of the Year.
- AP Third-Team All-American last year.
- Went for 15 points, nine rebounds and three blocks against California on Friday.
- Has dramatically improved her free-throw shooting this season, hitting 74.4 percent (29-39) of her shots from the line after entering the year as a 56.5 percent FT shooter.
- Oregon State's all-time leader in career blocks with 343, and sits second in Pac-12 history. Hamblin would need 59 more rejections to match current Pac-12 record holder Stefanie Kasperski (Oregon, 1987-90).
- Has hit 44 of her 70 shots over the last six games (62.9 percent).
- Is averaging 10.6 rebounds per game over her last 12 games.
- Hamblin is the NCAA's active leader in career blocks, leading Breanna Stewart (330).
- Became the 20th player in Oregon State history to reach the 1,000 career point mark vs. USC on Jan. 2.
- Earned Second-Team Academic All-America honors last year, posting a 3.86 GPA as a Mechanical Engineering major.
- Is on schedule to graduate a quarter early, finishing her school work at the end of winter quarter.
- She was affectionately dubbed "The Canadian Hammer" by former Oregon State men's basketball standout Joe Burton during her freshman season.
- Hamblin is said to have "turned the corner" midway through her sophomore season. After scoring in double figures four times in her first 39 collegiate games, Hamblin has reached double-digits 43 times in her last 66 games, including five 20-point performances.

THE GIFT OF GABBY: Gabriella Hanson Quick Hitters

- Set career highs in points (20) and assists (6) against California on Friday, shooting 8-for-12 from the floor and 4-for-7 from 3-point range.
- Posted the best set of back-to-back games in her collegiate career to end the month of December, scoring 19 points against Cal Poly and 18 points against Notre Dame.
- Is averaging 13.1 points per game over her last seven games.
- Is second on the team with 43 assists and leads the Beavers with 22 steals.
- Has at least one assist in every game this season and has at least three assists in three-straight games.
- Made her first career start in the season-opener after serving as the team's "sixth man" last year.
- Is ninth in Oregon State history with a career 3-point percentage of 34.4.
- Was a Pac-12 All-Academic Honorable Mention last season.

- Has missed the Beavers' last seven games due to injury. Wiese had previously made 71-consecutive starts since joining the program in 2013.
- Became the 19th player in Oregon State history to reach the 1,000-point mark when she knocked down a free throw in the final minutes of the Beavers' game against Idaho on Dec. 12.
