What To Look For

- Kelsey Plum owns the national lead in scoring, averaging 27.2 points per game.
- The Huskies No. 25 ranking in the AP Poll is their first ranking since March 3, 2003.
- Plum needs 26 points to reach 2,000 in her career and become the fastest in Pac-12 history (87 games).
- The Dawgs weekend sweep of UCLA and USC was the first against ranked teams since 2001.
- Plum earned Pac-12 and USBWA National POW honors after the Huskies wins over UCLA and USC.
- Plum is now third on the UW all-time scoring list with 1,974 points, passing Giuliana Mendiola vs USC.
- The Huskies RPI is up to No. 17, fifth in the Pac-12 behind Stanford, UCLA, Oregon St., ASU and UCLA.
- The Huskies are third in the Pac-12 in points per game, averaging 75.9 per contest.
- Chantel Osahor is averaging a double-double (10.5 pts / 10.3 reb) and had a career-best 24 at Colorado.
- Osahor has six double-double this season, while Talia Walton has five.
- Walton is seventh in the Pac-12 in scoring at 16.7 ppg, notching double figures in 17 of 19 contests.
- Osahor leads all post players in the Pac-12 with a 1.9 assist to turnover ratio (60 assists / 32 TO's).
- The Huskies were picked sixth by both the coaches and the media in the Pac-12 preseason polls.
- Osahor became the fourth player in program history with a 20-rebound game vs. Seattle U.
- Walton's 33 points in the opener were a career high, while her eight 3's were second-most in UW history.
- Mathilde Gilling leads the Dawgs in bench minutes at 14.8 a game, averaging 3.6 points per game.
- Plum and Walton became the 12th and 13th players in program history to reach 1,500 points.
- Dating back to last year, the Dawgs have won 21 of their last 25 home games.
- The Dawgs are 2nd in the Pac-12 with 7.3 3-pointers per game. Walton leads the conference with 48 made.
- The Huskies two non-conference losses came against ranked teams, #21 Oklahoma and #23 Syracuse.
- The Dawgs are now 2-3 against ranked teams after beating No. 17 UCLA and No. 25 USC in Pac-12 play.
- Mike Neighbors is 3rd among active Pac-12 coaches with a conference winning percentage of .614 (27-17).
- Plum leads the nation in free throws made with 146.
- Alexis Atchley took over as a starter due to the injury to Brianna Ruiz, averaging 10.0 ppg over last three.
- The win over South Dakota was the 50th of Mike Neighbors' head coaching career (Now 58-28 all-time).
- UW's top-three scorers (Plum/Walton/Osahor) have combined to shoot 216-256 (84.4%) from the foul line.
- Walton (216) has a shot of breaking the UW record for 3-pointers made held by Jazmine Davis (265).
- After leading the nation in FT percentage last year, UW is 11th so far this season at 76.5 percent.

Directions: Located on the southeast section of the Washington campus and 40 minutes north of Sea-Tac Airport. From Interstate-5, take the Hwy. 520 exit toward Bellevue-Kirkland (east). Travel 1/4 mile and take the Montlake Boulevard exit. At the end of the off ramp, there is a stop light at Montlake Blvd. Turn LEFT. Travel across the Montlake Bridge. Husky Stadium will be visible on the RIGHT with Bank of America Arena visible to the north of the stadium. To access E-10, E-11 or E-12 parking lots, turn RIGHT at the stoplight by the stadium marquee.

Previous Matchups With Stanford

The Dawgs are 15-45 all-time against Stanford, including just 4-25 in Palo Alto. The Huskies last defeated the Cardinal in 2014 in Seattle when Stanford was ranked No. 3 in nation, but Washington prevailed, 87-82. The Huskies last won at Stanford back in 1999, prevailing 74-62.

Scouting Stanford

Coming off of a loss at UCLA for the first time since 2006, #16 Stanford is 5-3 in conference and 15-5 overall. The Cardinal are currently in fifth place in the conference, but have played just two Pac-12 games at home where they are 2-0 as opposed to 3-3 away. Stanford is paced by leading scorer Lili Thompson, who is scoring 14.3 points per game so far in her junior season. Karlie Samuelson, the team captain is 17th in the nation in 3-point field goal percentage at .439. The other team captain, Erica McCall, posted back-to-back double-doubles in Pac-12 home wins against Utah and Colorado.

Previous Matchups With Cal

Washington is 44-21 all-time against Cal, including splitting with the Bears last season. The Dawgs won 79-77 in Seattle, before falling 82-58 in Berkeley. The Dawgs last won in Berkeley in 2014, taking that game 70-65. Overall, Washington is 20-12 in Berkeley.

Scouting Cal

Cal has started the Pac-12 season 1-7 with their most recent loss against now ranked #15 UCLA on the road. Kristine Anigwe, their leading scorer, is averaging 20.4 points per game. She is also 14th in nation for field goal percentage at 57.8 percent. Courtney Range is the team's second leading scorer at 13.7 points per game so far in her junior season. The Bears were 9-2 in their non-conference games, scoring over 100 points in three of those games and being ranked inside the top-25 for much of that stretch.

Plum's Honors

Kelsey Plum in an All-America candidate and is piling up honors this season. Recently, she was one of 16 players named to the Ann Meyers Drysdale Midseason Watch List for national player of the year. For the week of January 11-17, she earned the USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Week, while also being named Pac-12 Player of the Week. She was also named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 20 as a Player of the Year candidate. She was named the No. 10 player in the country on the list compiled by ESPNW. Plum was also named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 30, the Naismith Early Season Watch List and the preseason All-Pac-12 Team.

Walton On The Perimeter

The Huskies have a bigger front line this season, allowing Talia Walton to see more time on the perimeter. That shift has been a positive for the match up nightmare as she is averaging career bests in scoring and shooting percentages. She also already has games of 33 and 29 points, while making a Pac-12 best 48 3-pointers on the year. Walton has also been a defensive threat on the perimeter where she leads the team with 39 steals, using her long arms and instincts that made her the UW all-time leader in blocked shots when she played inside more.

Plum's Scoring Prowess

Kelsey Plum has now scored in double figures in 84 of 86 career games, including at least 20 points 58 times and 18 games of at least 30. She now holds the Washington record for games of at least 20 points, breaking Jazmine Davis' record of 51 at Washington State. The record for games in double figures is 98 by Giuliana Mendiola. Plum already holds the record for 30-point games with 18 of the 45 total top-scoring games in Husky history. Plum also holds the Washington records with 746 points and 22.6 ppg scoring average both that led the Pac-12 last season. Plum also set Husky records with 45 points against Oklahoma and with 207 made free throws last year. She is currently ninth in the NCAA among active scorers with 1,974 points and the only junior in the top-20. She is also second among active players in scoring average at 23.0 ppg. Plum is just 24 points shy of becoming the 17th player in Pac-12 history to reach 2,000 points and could become only the 11th player in NCAA history to score 3,000 points next year.

Veteran Roster

Washington has yet to start a player without at least three years in the program and the main players off the bench were seniors giving the Dawgs an extremely experienced look. The usual starters included fifth-year senior Talia Walton, redshirt junior Katie Collier, true juniors Kelsey Plum and Chantel Osahor and redshirt sophomore Brianna Ruiz. After the injury to Ruiz, senior Alexis Atchley has entered the starting lineup, leaving her role as sixth man. The main reserve option is now Mathilde Gilling leads the team in bench minutes. Overall, Washington has seen 3,520 of the possible 3,800 minutes (92.6 percent) played by Huskies with at least three years in the program.

Size In The Paint

After being perimeter oriented the past several seasons, the Huskies have a new look this season with some size in the paint. Talia Walton has moved mostly to the '3', while Chantel Osahor, Katie Collier, Deja Strother and Mathilde Gilling have played nearly all of the minutes inside. It gives the Huskies a big lineup with each being at least 6' 2".

Dawgs Beat WSU, Sweep Season Series

Washington earned the season sweep over Washington State, winning 69-63 on their home floor. Kelsey Plum scored 24 points, but it was a career-best 15 points from Alexis Atchley, including four 3-pointers that was the difference. The Dawgs blew a big early lead, but came back in the fourth quarter for the win.

Dawgs Earn LA Sweep, Beat #25 USC

The Huskies swept a pair of ranked teams on the weekend, downing No. 25 USC, 69-60. Kelsey Plum poured in 32 points, while Chantel Osahor had 14 and 11 as the Huskies came from 10 down at the half.

Huskies Take Down #17 UCLA

The Dawgs earned their first win of the season over a ranked opponent, downing No. 17 UCLA, 64-56. Kelsey Plum led the way with 23 points, making 11-12 from the foul line, but it was a timely 22 from Talia Walton who made big shots down the stretch. Alexis Atchley stepped into the starting role, scoring 8 points.

Dawgs Top Arizona

Washington had a complete performance against Arizona to win comfortably, 63-47. Kelsey Plum scored 26 points, while Talia Walton added 18 and Chantel Osahor ripped down 19 rebounds. The Dawgs defense was also strong, holding the Wildcats to just 47 points, forcing 14 turnovers and allowing just 28 percent shooting.

Huskies Can't Hold On Vs. #14 ASU

Washington used a big third quarter to take a lead to the fourth against 14th-ranked Arizona State, but could not hang on, falling 68-61. Kelsey Plum had 21 points to lead all scorers, while Chantel Osahor scored 15 to go with five rebounds, five assists, four steals and two blocks.

Dawgs Fall At Utah

UW dropped its first Pac-12 game of the season, falling to Utah, 88-83. Kelsey Plum scored 35 points, including making 15-17 free throws, but the Huskies could not get enough stops down the stretch. Talia Walton had her fifth double-double, while Osahor scored 18 points, but fouled out after playing just 20 minutes.

Dawgs Win Wild One In Boulder

Washington led by as many as 20 in the first half, but Colorado came all the way back to lead by five in the fourth quarter. The Huskies responded in the post led by a career-best 24 points from Chantel Osahor who also added 11 rebounds. Talia Walton also had 24, while Mathilde Gilling had a career-best 10 off the bench.

Dawgs Open Pac-12 Play With Win In Pullman

Kelsey Plum scored 33 points to lead Washington to a comfortable 79-64 win over Washington State to open Pac-12 play in Pullman. The Dawgs had four players in double figures, including Brianna Ruiz who had 12 on four 3-pointers. Overall, the Dawgs made 12 3's with Plum making five and Talia Walton making three.

Huskies Close Non-Conference By Beating Weber State

The Dawgs used a 29-0 run in the first half to build a big lead over Weber State and cruise to a 69-56 victory. Kelsey Plum led the Huskies with 25 points, but four scored in double figures as the Dawgs were able to experiment with lineups with a double-digit lead virtually the whole game.

Dawgs Rout UC Riverside

After coming back from 17 down to beat UC Riverside last season, the Dawgs cruised to a big 78-43 win this year at Alaska Airlines Arena. Kelsey Plum scored 27 points to lead all scorers as the Huskies blew it open early, using a 34-2 run in the first half to build a big lead.

Huskies End South Dakota's Home Winning Streak

Washington ended South Dakota's 18-game home winning streak, beating the Coyotes, 77-64. The Dawgs trailed by as many as 14 in the first quarter after allowing a 19-0 run. UW then chipped away at the lead and eventually blew things open in the fourth quarter led by 29 points from Talia Walton and 25 from Kelsey Plum.

#21 Oklahoma Squeaks Past UW Late

Washington led by as many as six in the fourth quarter, but Oklahoma used a late run to beat the Huskies, 71-68. Kelsey Plum finished with 30 points, including 16 in the fourth quarter, but it was not enough. Chantel Osahor added a double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds in the loss.

Huskies Down Portland

Portland got off to a hot start, making five 3's in the first quarter, but Washington took over in the second quarter. Kelsey Plum led the way with 29 points, making a season-high six 3-pointers to lead the Dawgs to a 83-65 win. Talia Walton added 17 points and Chantel Osahor had a double-double for UW.

Plum Propels UW Past Texas Tech

Washington trailed by eight at the half, but Kelsey Plum scored 19 of her 34 points in the third quarter to lead the Dawgs past Texas Tech, 77-73. Talia Walton added a double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds and was named to the All-Tourney Team, while Mathilde Gilling gave great minutes off the bench with nine points.

Huskies Suffer First Loss To #23 Syracuse

UW suffered their first loss of the season, falling to No. 23 Syracuse 66-62 in Las Vegas. The Dawgs got off to a sluggish start and trailed by as many 21, before a big comeback to get within one in the fourth quarter. Talia Walton led the way with 22 points and 11 rebounds, making four 3's, while Kelsey Plum added 19.

Dawgs Run Away From San Diego State

Kelsey Plum scored 32 points for the second-straight game as Washington pulled away from San Diego State in the second half. Leading by as few as three in the third quarter, the Dawgs ran away and won 80-51. Talia Walton added 19 points, while Brianna Ruiz had 12.

Dawgs Come Back To Beat Fresno State

The Huskies trailed by as many as seven points in the second half, but rallied to beat Fresno State, 89-79. Kelsey Plum led the way with 32 points and six assists, scoring 21 in the second half to lead the Dawgs back. Chantel Osahor (17), Katie Collier (16) and Brianna Ruiz (15) also had career highs.

UW Claims City Rivalry

UW claimed the city rivalry game, beating Seattle U., 96-55. Kelsey Plum led all scorers with 26 points and added six assists, but it was Chantel Osahor who posted the most impressive numbers. Osahor had 12 points, 20 boards, four assists and three steals. She became the fourth UW player with a 20-rebound game.

Dawgs Rout SCU In Opener

Washington blew out Santa Clara 100-55 in the opener behind a career-best 33 points from Talia Walton. The senior made 8-9 from behind the 3-point line, while adding nine rebounds, six steals and four assists. As a team the Dawgs shot over 50 percent from the field and Kelsey Plum added 25 points and eight assists.

2014-15 In Review

Washington returned to the NCAA Tournament last year off the strength of a 11-1 non-conference record and fifth-place finish in the Pac-12. Washington picked up some signature wins along the way, defeating Florida State at the Cancun Challenge, then upsetting No. 5 Texas A&M and No. 7 Oregon State at Alaska Airlines Arena. Overall, Washington now has three-straight wins over top-10 teams at home, having also upset No. 3 Stanford in 2014. For the season, the Huskies finished 23-10, falling to Miami (Fla.) in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Washington was selected as a top-20 team during the midseason look by the NCAA and earned a No. 6 seed in the Big Dance. The Dawgs finished 11-7 in conference and beat Utah in the first round of the Pac-12 Tournament. The Huskies also led the conference in scoring at 75.0 ppg and led the nation in free-throw shooting at 78.0 percent.

Graduated Greats

Washington lost two of the program's all-time great players to graduation in guard Jazmine Davis and forward Aminah Williams. Davis left as the Huskies all-time leading scorer, while Williams is the all-time leading rebounder. Both players will be missed, but the Huskies believe they have the depth to overcome the losses of two greats that helped rebuild the program from a Pac-12 afterthought to a NCAA Tournament team. The duo won 84 games at Washington, never less than 20 in a season. Davis scored 2,277 points in her Husky career, leaving as the all-time leading scorer, but also sixth in Pac-12 history. She also holds the Husky record for free throws, 3-pointers, field goals attempted, 3-pointers attempted and free throws attempted. Davis is also the only four-time All-Pac-12 Player in Washington history. Williams was probably the best rebounder in the country for her size, measuring at 6-0, but averaging 10.8 rpg as a sophomore, 10.4 as a junior and 9.3 as a senior. Her 1,142 total rebounds are a UW record, but she also holds the school record for games played at 132.

2014-15 Pac-12 Honors

Jazmine Davis and Kelsey Plum earned All-Pac-12 honors with Davis becoming the first four-time recipient in Washington history. Talia Walton was also named Honorable Mention All-Pac-12, while Aminah Williams was Honorable Mention All-Defensive Team.

HEAD COACH MIKE NEIGHBORS - @coachneighbors

Mike Neighbors enters his third season as the head coach at Washington and fifth with the Huskies overall. He was promoted to head coach on April 21, 2013. He had previously worked as the top assistant coach for two seasons with the Huskies.

Neighbors has overseen the resurgence of the Husky program, including the Dawgs first trip to the NCAA tournament in eight seasons. Last year, Washington won 23 games, the most since 1995 and defeated five teams ranked in the top-25 at some point during the season. Those wins included beating No. 5 Texas A&M, No. 7 Oregon State and Florida State who finished with a No. 7 ranking and made the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament.

Neighbors record now includes wins over 10 ranked teams in two seasons, while owning a career Pac-12 winning percentage of .583 (21-15), which ranks third among active conference coaches behind only Tara Vanderveer and Lindsay Gottlieb.

In 2015, the Dawgs also earned their first national ranking since 2003 when they earned a spot in the top-25 of the Coaches Poll. The Huskies were named midseason as one of the top-20 teams in the country in the NCAA Tournament Early Look. The Dawgs would go onto earn a No. 6 seed in the NCAA's, traveling to Iowa City where they were upset by No. 11 Miami in an exciting up-tempo game that went down to the final possessions.

In his first year at the helm of the Husky program, Neighbors led the Dawgs to a third-straight 20-win season and trip to the quarterfinals of the WNIT. Washington finished 20-14, including 10-8 in the Pac-12. The Dawgs defeated five teams that were ranked at some point during the season, including an upset of then-No. 3 Stanford at Alaska Airlines Arena in front of a nationally televised audience. The win ended the 58-game road conference winning streak of the Cardinal.

Neighbors has overseen the development of several individuals, including Jazmine Davis who was named All-Pac-12 First Team all four seasons, becoming the first player in Washington history to achieve that distinction. Under Neighbors' tutelage, Davis would also become the Dawgs all-time leading scorer, while breaking nearly every school offensive record in the process. Neighbors also has continued to develop two other players that would break major school records with Aminah Williams and Talia Walton taking down the school's all-time rebounding and blocked shots records.

In addition to the continued development of the veteran players, Neighbors two seasons have overseen the best start to a career of any Husky player ever. As a freshman, Kelsey Plum set the single-season scoring record at UW with 712 points, while also earning Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and Freshman All-America honors from several news outlets. This past season, Plum surpassed her scoring record with 746 points, while leading the Pac-12 in scoring at 22.8 points per game. She was named to nearly every watch list, including being named a finalist for the Wooden Award, being named WNCA All-Region and once again to the All-Pac-12 First Team.

Previously as an assistant, Neighbors worked with the team's guards, including Davis who through two seasons has scored more points than any Husky in school history. He was regarded as one of the country's best defensive and player-development specialists.

In 2013, Neighbors helped the Huskies to a second-straight 20-win season and a return trip to the WNIT. Washington finished 21-12, including 11-7 in the Pac-12, good for a fifth-place finish.

In his first year at UW, Neighbors assisted the Husky women to a 20-14 season and trip to the quarterfinals of the WNIT. It was the first 20-win season for UW since 2002-03. Neighbors also saw the development of guard Jazmine Davis, who was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year after averaging 15.7 points for the season.

Neighbors' accomplishments in women's basketball speak for themselves. He's helped sign nine McDonald's All-Americans, including incoming freshman Deja Strother who joins Katie Collier and Plum as McDonald's All-Americans on the Huskies roster. He has seen eight of his players drafted in the WNBA, including three who have won WNBA Championships. Everywhere Neighbors has coached, he's overseen the development of either the No. 1 or No. 2 all-time leading scorer in program history, most recently with Davis at UW. Neighbors is a regular speaker at coaching conventions and clinics around the nation, and his weekly newsletter is popular with coaches at all levels.

Neighbors came to Seattle after four seasons at Xavier, where he worked with former Huskies coach Kevin McGuff. During Neighbors' tenure in Cincinnati, he helped mold a Musketeers program that established itself as one of the best in the nation. Neighbors was named one of basketballscout.com's "Rising Stars" in 2009, an award that recognizes assistant coaches who are some of the best in the business.

While at Xavier, Neighbors was a part of a coaching staff that produced some of the best seasons in school history. During the 2009-10 season, the Musketeers posted a 30-4 record, including a flawless 14-0 season in Atlantic-10 Conference play. Xavier ended the season ranked No. 5 in the polls. In addition, Xavier advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament.

In his final year at Xavier, Neighbors helped lead the program to a 29-3 record and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament's Second Round. During his tenure at Xavier, Neighbors was part of a staff that compiled a 61-5 non-conference record (108-22 overall), captured three A-10 Tournaments, three A-10 Regular Season Champs, and competed in four straight NCAA Tournaments.

Neighbors is also considered an excellent recruiter, and helped the Musketeers ink the No. 18 rated class of 2010 according to ESPN Hoopgurlz.

As the coach responsible for developing post players, Neighbors was instrumental in the growth of Amber Harris and Ta'Shia Phillips, two of the best players in Musketeer history. Harris, a 6-5 forward, was a two-time State Farm All-America selection and was drafted fourth overall by the WNBA's Minnesota Lynx. Meanwhile, Phillips was noted as one of the premier defensive players in the nation. The 6-6 center was the leading rebounder in XU history, in addition to her numerous national accolades.

Neighbors came to XU from the University of Arkansas, where he was an assistant coach for a season, his second stint in Fayetteville. Prior to returning to his alma mater, Neighbors was an assistant coach at the University of Colorado and the University of Tulsa, both under Kathy McConnell-Miller. In Boulder, Neighbors helped develop the school's all-time leading scorer in Brittany Spears, a 2011 WNBA draft selection. At Tulsa, Neighbors was an assistant on the up-and-coming Hurricane's program that enjoyed back-to-back postseason appearances.

A native of Greenwood, Ark., Neighbors received his bachelor's degree from the University of Arkansas in 1993. Following his graduation, Neighbors was a director of basketball operations for the women's basketball program, serving under legendary coach Gary Blair, who won the NCAA Championship in 2011 with Texas A&M. Before moving into the collegiate ranks, Neighbors was a highly successful head coach in the Arkansas girls' high school ranks. His most notable achievement was taking a 1-24 Bentonville team to the State Championships two years later.

Neighbors has two children, one daughter Abby (18) and a son Alec (12). He lives in Seattle.
