**ABOUT THE BUFFS:** Colorado is 6-19 overall and 1-13 in Pac-12 play. The Buffaloes fell in both games last weekend at Oregon State and Oregon, and have dropped four consecutive contests.

On the offensive end, the Buffaloes are averaging 62.5 points per game while shooting 39.6 percent from the field. Colorado is shooting 72.3 percent at the free throw line, which ranks fifth in the Pac-12 Conference. The team also ranks in the top half of the conference from long distance as they are fifth in the league, connecting on 34.2 percent of its shots behind the arc.

Defensively, Colorado has allowed 69.3 points per game on 41.5 percent from the field. The Buffaloes average 36.8 rebounds and are sixth in the Pac-12 with 4.2 blocked shots per game.

Senior forward **Jamee Swan** has been the team's top scorer and rebounder throughout the season, averaging 13.4 points and 6.9 rebounds while hitting 44.6 percent from the field and 68.5 percent from the free throw line. Swan has also recorded a team-leading 41 blocks on the season and three double-doubles.

Swan ranks 13th in the Pac-12 in scoring, ninth in field goal percentage, 13th in overall rebounding, ninth in free throw percentage, is 11th with 5.0 defensive rebounds per game and is fourth in blocked shots (1.8 bpg).

Freshman **Kennedy Leonard** has made a significant impact for the Buffaloes in her debut season as the team's starting point guard and continues to grow into a leadership role on the floor. She enters the game as Colorado's second highest scorer, averaging 11.3 points per game and has also dished out a team-leading 110 assists, averaging 4.4 in each contest.

On the Pac-12 leaderboard, Leonard is 20th in scoring, seventh in assists, 12th in assist/turnover ratio (1.2) and tied for 13th in steals (1.4 spg).

Junior guard **Haley Smith** is having a strong 2015-16 campaign on both defense and offense. She's averaging 10.3 points per game and is second on the team with 5.6 rebounds. She has been one of Colorado's most accurate shooters from the field at 46.5 percent and at the free throw line where she has gone 35-of-39 (.897).

Smith ranks 26th overall in the conference in scoring and 20th in rebounding.

Junior wing **Lauren Huggins** is averaging 8.0 points per game and is second on the team in 3-point shooting, connecting on 44-of-114 of her shots totaling a 39.9 field goal percentage from behind the arc. In ten Pac-12 games this season, Huggins has shot 40.0 percent from the 3-point line and tied a career-high with five treys against Arizona. The Littleton, Colo. native averages 2.1 3-point field goals per game. Huggins missed last Sunday's game at Oregon with the flu.

Freshman guard **Alexis Robinson** has been a mainstay in the starting line up since early on in Pac-12 play. The Ashland, Ky. native is averaging 8.4 points, 3.4 rebounds and 2.7 assists. She is shooting 36.7 percent from the 3-point line, third-best on the team. Robinson had one of her best offensive performances of her young career against UMass when she scored a personal-best 21 points and her best defensive performance came in the Buffs' Pac-12 opener when she held Washington's Kelsey Plum to a season low 18 points, 10 below her nation leading average of 28.1 per game at the time.

Freshman **Makenzie Ellis** has earned back-to-back starts after providing a nice spark off the bench. She is averaging 3.2 points and 3.0 rebounds a game, and is shooting 39.1 percent from the field.

Junior **Zoe Beard-Fails** leads the reserves in scoring and rebounding. She is averaging 4.4 points and 3.3 rebounds while shooting 44.2 percent from the field.

Sophomore center **Zoe Correal** is averaging 2.3 points and 3.4 rebounds and is second on the team in blocked shots with 16 total. All 15 of her career starts have come this season.

**ABOUT STANFORD:** The Stanford Cardinal are 20-6 overall and 10-4 in the Pac-12. The Cardinal, ranked No. 15 in this week's *Associated Press* and *USA Today Sports WBCA* polls, have won five of their last six games. They are averaging 66.5 points per game and shooting 41.5 percent from the field. Stanford allows 53.7 points per game and owns the second-ranked defense in the league in terms of opponent field goal percentage, holding teams to 32.3 percent from the field.

A pair of Cardinal are averaging double-figures in scoring with junior

guard Lili Thompson leading Stanford and is 10th in the Pac-12 at 14.6 points per game. Junior forward Erica McCall is the Cardinal's second double-digit scorer and top rebounder, tallying 13.1 points and 9.4 rebounds per game. She ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in rebounding and is third in blocked shots, averaging 2.0 on the season. Collectively, the Cardinal block 6.0 shots per game, which ranks second in the conference.

Tara VanDerveer is in her 30th season at the helm for Stanford with a record of 821-172 and owns a 973-223 career mark, now in her 37th year as a head coach.

**THE SERIES:** This will be the 19th meeting between Colorado and Stanford with the Cardinal holding an 14-4 advantage in the series. Stanford has won the last nine, all since Colorado joined the Pac-12 for the 2011-12 season. The Cardinal won this season's earlier meeting, a 71-56 decision in Stanford on Jan. 10. Colorado's last win over Stanford came in 2002 when the Buffs defeated the Cardinal, 62-59, in the NCAA Regional Semifinal in Boise, Idaho. Colorado is 2-4 all-time against the Cardinal at home.

Linda Lappe is 0-9 against Stanford as a head coach. Tara VanDerveer is 14-4 against Colorado as a head coach.

**WHAT'S NEXT?:** The Buffaloes host California on Sunday, then finish their regular season campaign on the road next weekend, traveling to play the Washington schools. Colorado faces Washington State on Thursday, Feb. 25 and then battles Washington on Saturday, Feb. 27, which will be televised on the Pac-12 Networks.

**PLAY4KAY:** The Buffaloes will wear pink on Friday in honor of breast cancer awareness. The Play 4Kay initiative raises awareness and funds for research in the fight against breast cancer. This season Colorado has partnered with the Play4Kay organization to help that cause. Stand Shoulder to Shoulder with our Play 4Kay Team and help the Buffs make a difference. **DISHING ASSISTS:** **Kennedy Leonard** has 110 assists through 25 games this season, which is tied for fourth most all-time as a freshman. She is tied with her current coach and former Buff **Linda Lappe**, who also tallied 110 in her first season (1998-99) she played at Colorado.

**BLOCKING SHOTS:** **Jamee Swan** leads the team with 41 blocks this season and it ranks third all-time in the Colorado senior record book. She only needs six to break the class record.

**CHALLENGING SCHEDULE:** Colorado has played the 15th toughest schedule in the nation (through games of Feb. 16) as its opponents have a combined record of 312-197 (.613). The Buffaloes are fourth in the Pac-12 trailing only Stanford (third, .656), UCLA (sixth, .634) and Arizona State (11th, .622).

The Buffaloes own the 14th most difficult schedule in the country when looking at their cumulative schedule. Past and future opponents are a combined 312-197 (.613).

**DOUBLE-DOUBLE RARITY:** Freshman **Kennedy Leonard** recorded her first career double-double with 15 points and a career-high 10 assists against then-No. 13 Kentucky on Nov. 22 in Lexington, becoming just the fifth player in school history to earn a points-assists double-double.

**SWAN REACHES 1,000:** Senior **Jamee Swan** became the 28th player in school history to reach 1,000 career points on Saturday, Dec. 19 as the Buffaloes defeated Presbyterian 72-60 at the Coors Events Center. She scored her 1,000th career point on a layup with 2:55 remaining in the third quarter and finished the game with 16 points.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Senior **Jamee Swan** has recorded a double-digit scoring effort in 17 of 23 games played this season to lead the Buffs offensively as she is averaging 13.4 points. Swan also has a

**STANFORD, Calif.** — Sunday afternoon's match-up against No. 9 Stanford felt reminiscent of Friday night's tough loss for the Colorado women's basketball team. Despite a fast start and improved field goal shooting, the Buffaloes couldn't find a way to clinch a Pac-12 victory in California, falling 71-56 to the Cardinal.

Even in defeat, the Buffs' effort was defined by Linda Lappe-level defense. CU's coach said her team "came out swinging . . . the way that we came out of the gates showed a lot, and you know anytime we have a game like the one we had against Cal, you can put your tail between your legs or you can come out swinging. And I thought we came out swinging. It was our aggressiveness, and that everybody was engaged."

Colorado (5-10 overall, 0-4 Pac-12) jumped out to a 7-0 lead, taking advantage of Stanford's zone to put points on the board from the perimeter. Jumpers from Haley Smith, Kennedy Leonard and Bri Watts maintained the lead, but junior Lauren Huggins was absent from beyond the arc. CU's dominant three-point shooter went 0-3 from the field after taking two early fouls. Sophomore Kaylee Johnson broke Stanford's early silence at the 6:15 mark, and continued to produce for the Cardinal (13-3, 3-1 Pac-12) throughout the first half. The Buffs maintained the lead until a minute remained in the first quarter, but at the buzzer found themselves in the same spot as Friday night — tied 14-14.

"Overall we were just solid in moving the ball on offense and finding gaps, finding open shots, and I thought we set better screens," Lappe said. "Haley Smith I thought had an outstanding game, made things happen. She probably played one of her best games of her career."

Smith finished with 17 points and nine rebounds, shooting 8-of-13 from the field. She led Colorado through a second quarter that could have paralleled Friday night's scoreless period at Cal. The Buffs, playing without leading scorer Jamee Swan (lower back) for a second consecutive game, endured a 3:18 scoring drought mid-quarter and shot 18.8 percent. But defense and poor Cardinal shooting — 36 percent for the half — kept the Buffs' deficit within single digits.

"I was thinking about my role a little more closely," Smith said. "I know my role is to put points on the board, to rebound and to be solid and limit turnovers. It's something I've been focusing on and I thought today was a good showcase of that."

Leonard recorded a blocked shot and gained her first personal foul in the quarter, with Watts, Zoe Correal and Huggins playing on two each. Smith led the court behind Johnson with 9 points at half, shooting 4-of-6 from the field and making her only 3-point attempt. CU heated up just a bit in the third quarter, deflating Stanford's lead to only four points at the 5:30 mark. Freshman Alexis Robinson took over as the Buffs' leading scorer at the time, racking up 11 points by the end of the quarter, and 15 overall. A Stanford jumper broke the Buffs' 7-0 run with 5:20 to play, and the momentum swung just outside of Colorado's reach for the next few minutes. Huggins came out after her fourth personal foul and did not take the court again until the fourth quarter.

"(Huggins) was in foul trouble early, but she stayed aggressive and stayed engaged," Lappe said. "You have to be resilient in athletics, that's for sure, because no opponent cares what you're feeling or that you're having a tough time. You just have to be able to come back and keep going."

Huggins wasn't the only Buff watching fouls; Correal and Watts were also in danger during the quarter, contributing to Stanford's six trips to the free throw line. Only six points came from 11 free throws in the quarter, although Stanford had 19 points from the line that Colorado couldn't reciprocate. Colorado's shooting peaked at 33 percent for the quarter, but good looks by Leonard and Robinson from the outside kept CU within 10. Smith hit a jumper with a minute to play, and Colorado entered the fourth quarter trailing by nine points.

The Buffs kept knocking on the door in the fourth quarter, but the Cardinal's offensive rebounding and 12-of-15 shooting from the free throw line prevented CU from regaining a lead. Huggins played through the quarter with four fouls, but found her stroke from the 3-point arc in time to get the Buffs within seven points. She sank two early in the quarter, and after another basket by Robinson CU found itself within five points. But this is when the Buffs' luck ran out.

Stanford blazed a 10-0 run for the next 5 minutes, continuing to visit the free throw line and the lane despite Colorado's physicality. The Leonard vs. junior Briana Roberson matchup led to Leonard fouling out with under a minute to play, behind Correal. The Buffs went 7-of-17 from the field, mirroring the overall shooting percentage of 41 percent, and committed five turnovers during their scoring drought.



team-leading three double-doubles this season. She tallied her first (13 points, 10 rebounds) against Northern Colorado on Nov. 19., and then had a double-double in back-to-back games, against Presbyterian on Dec. 19 (16 points, 11 rebounds), allowing her to take over sole possession for 12th place on the all-time double-doubles list and her third came at Wyoming (28 points, 13 rebounds) on Dec. 21. Swan has 13 double-doubles in her career. Freshman **Kennedy Leonard** has 14 double-digit scoring performances, junior **Haley Smith** has 13 and freshman **Alexis Robinson** has 10. **Junior Lauren Huggins** has recorded seven and junior **Zoe Beard-Fails** along with sophomore **Brecca Thomas** have each tallied a pair of 10+ scoring games.

**RECORD BOOK WATCH:** Senior **Jamee Swan** and junior **Lauren Huggins** continue to climb rankings in the record books this season. Swan, who began the season in 17th place on the all-time rebounding list has since moved into eighth place. Swan has also moved from sixth place to third place on the all-time blocked shots list.

Huggins, who is shooting 38.6 from behind the arc this season has also made a move up the charts. From the beginning of the season, Huggins has climbed five places on the all-time list for most 3-point field goal attempts, from 16th to 11th place. In addition, she's moved four spots from 15th to 11th in the CU record book for most made 3-point field goals.

**HIGH FIVES:** Three times this season the Buffaloes have finished a game with five players recording at least 10 points. Colorado accomplished this feat most recently against Washington in its Pac-12 opener. Freshman Kennedy Leonard and senior Jamee Swan scored 19 points, freshman Alexis Robinson tallied 13, junior Haley Smith finished with 12 and junior Lauren Huggins chipped in 11 points. The other two times a Buffs' quintet reached this mark was against Northern Arizona and Loyola Marymount.

**DOMINANT IN NON-CONFERENCE:** The Buffaloes have been dominant in regular season nonconference games under **Linda Lappe**. Colorado is 55-16 in that stretch since the beginning of the 2010-11 season. The Buffaloes have won 48 of their last 60 regular season nonconference contests.

**A MILESTONE WIN:** Head Coach **Linda Lappe** won her 100th career game at Colorado on Thursday, Nov. 19 as the Buffaloes defeated Northern Colorado 63-41 at the Coors Events Center. Lappe is 104-88 at the helm for the Buffs and her career head coaching record stands at 154-124 in eight-plus seasons.

**HOME AT THE CEC:** Colorado is traditionally tough at home with a 410-150 all-time record at the Coors Events Center (.732). The Buffaloes have won 10 or more games in a season at the CEC in 26 of 37 years. The Buffaloes have enjoyed five undefeated seasons (1980-83, 1992-94) at the CEC. Colorado was 10-7 at Coors in 2014-15.

**FOR OPENERS:** Colorado improved to 37-5 (.881) in all-time season openers and has won the last 16 straight. The Buffaloes started the season with a home game for the 29th time in 42 seasons. Colorado is an outstanding 40-2 (.952) all-time in home openers and has never lost its overall season opener when played at home (29-0).

**TALENTED GUARD CAYLAO-DO SIGNS NLI:** Quinessa Caylao-Do, a talented shooting guard from Tacoma, Wash. has signed a national letter of intent to continue her education and join the University of Colorado women's basketball team next fall, head coach Linda Lappe announced.

"Quinessa is a consummate team player who is a proven winner," Lappe said. "She is a versatile player who can defend, score, handle the ball and pass. We are excited to have her as a part of our buff family!"

The 5 foot, 9-inch shooting guard proved to play a pivotal role in her team's State Tournament run last season. As a junior, she scored a game-high 18 points as she guided Todd Beamer High School to a program-best third-place finish at the 2015 Class 4A State Girls'

voted the 2014-15 SPSP 4A Northwest Division Most Valuable Player, which Rice highlights as the biggest moment of her high school career thus far. Her MVP honors came in the same year she helped Todd Beamer qualify for the state tournament for the first time in school history. She also was named The News Tribune's Girls All-Area Basketball Player of the Year.

In addition to her consistent contributions to the Titans, Rice played AAU for Tree of Hope in the Nike Elite Youth Basketball League, the same team current Buff **Haley Smith** was a member of during her prep career. Rice's team placed second in 2014 and then earned a third place finish in 2015 at Nike Nationals.

**BUFFS ON TV:** Colorado women's basketball will be televised to a regional or national audience at least 15 times during the regular season, including 14 games on the Pac-12 Networks during league play. This marks the fourth consecutive year the Buffaloes will have double-digit regional or national television appearances.

Colorado made their 2015-16 television debut on Saturday, Dec. 12 when the Buffs hosted former Big-12 opponent Missouri at the Coors Events Center.

Colorado's first four Pac-12 games will be televised on the Pac-12 Networks as will seven of the Buffaloes' nine home conference games. All remaining home games, and conference road games, that aren't televised will be scheduled to be streamed live through Colorado's Pac-12.com video portal.

Entering this season, Colorado has tipped off on 143 national or regional telecasts since the fall of 2001, and 44 since the advent of the Pac-12 Networks in 2012.

**BUFFS PICKED NINTH:** In what is expected to be one of the most competitive league races in recent memory, Colorado was tabbed to finish ninth in the 2015-16 Pac-12 Conference standings according to the annual coaches preseason poll, announced at Pac-12 Media Day on Oct. 14.

Oregon State was voted the preseason favorite for the first time in the history of the poll, claiming 121 points and 11 first place votes. Stanford was second with 104 overall points. The other first place nod went to Arizona State, selected to finish third overall with 102.

California and UCLA were fourth with 88 points apiece followed by was fourth with 84 points followed by Washington (68), USC (60), Oregon (52), Colorado (39), Washington State (30), Utah (23) and Arizona (17).

In the media's preseason poll, Colorado was also picked ninth with 88 points.

**BUFFS HOST FIFTH ANNUAL ONE-ON-ONE EVENT AHEAD OF SEASON TIP OFF:** The University of Colorado women's basketball team welcomed fans to the Coors Events Center on Tuesday evening for its fifth annual One-On-One event.

A favorite among many, the premise of the One-On-One event is to have each student-athlete pair up with a prominent female member of the university's faculty/staff and get to know them outside of a classroom or office setting. The pairs then introduce each other to fans in attendance for the main program.

The campus leaders participating this year included department directors, professors and PhD candidates.

Student-athletes and their presenters first sat down at a team dinner to learn about one another. After the dinner concluded, the public event began with a reception where players, the coaching staff and campus leaders greeted the fans in attendance. Former head coach Ceal Barry, who held a similar event during her tenure, served as the event's emcee and brought each player and presenter to the stage.

Each presenter introduced their student-athlete and what they learned about them before asking a question for the player to answer. Ques-
