**THE GAME:** The No. 7/7 Oregon State women's basketball team (24-3, 15-1 Pac-12) opens its final regular season weekend of the year on Friday, when it heads to the Bay Area for a matchup with No. 13/13 Stanford (22-6, 12-4). The game is scheduled to tip off at 8 p.m.

**FOLLOW ALONG:** Friday's game will air live on Pac-12 Network, Pac-12 Oregon and Pac-12 Bay Area. Krista Blunk and Mary Murphy will have the call. Live audio will also be available with Ron Callan across the Beaver Radio Network, including on KEJO 1240 in Corvallis, as well as online at OSUBeavers.com. **COMING UP:** Oregon State will have a quick turnaround this weekend, as it wraps up its regular season Sunday against Cal at 11 a.m. The Pac-12 Tournament will begin on March 3 in Seattle, although the Beavers have already locked down a first-round bye and will begin playing on March 4. The NCAA Tournament Selection Show being broadcast on March 14.

**OREGON STATE QUICK HITTERS:**

- Oregon State is heading into a weekend with Pac-12 title implications, as the Beavers and Arizona State are tied for first in the conference at 15-1. OSU and ASU will both play at 11 a.m. on Sunday, with the Beavers heading to Cal and the Sun Devils playing at UCLA.
- Should the Beavers end Sun Devils split the Pac-12 crown, Oregon State would have the No. 1 seed in the Pac-12 Tournament by virtue of their head-to-head tiebreaker.
- Ruth Hamblin, Jamie Weisner and Sydney Wiese were all named to the Naismith Trophy Early Season Watch List (released Dec. 9). Oregon State is one of three schools in the country to place a trio of players on the list, joining Connecticut and South Carolina.
- Weisner was also named to the Naismith Trophy Midseason 30 on Feb. 10.
- Oregon State is one of three teams in the nation with three 1,000-point scorers (Hamblin, Weisner, Wiese), joining Connecticut and Southern Illinois.
- Oregon State's 14-game winning streak is tied for the longest in school history, matching the streak set back in 1982-83.
- The Beavers have won at least 10 straight games for the fourth time in the last three seasons (twice in 2014-15, once in 2013-14).
- OSU has won 20 games for the third-straight season and the 11th time in school history. The school record for wins is 27, set last season.
- Oregon State has been dominant in its 24 victories this season, holding one of the highest scoring margins in the nation at 17.9 points.
- The Beavers have controlled the glass this season, leading the nation in defensive rebounds per game (32.0) and sitting seventh in rebounding margin (11.8). California and Utah are the only teams to out-rebound Oregon State in a game this year (1/15 and 1/22).
- Oregon State has also been one of the best shooting teams in the country, hitting 44.4 percent of its field goal attempts and 35.8 percent of its 3-pointers.
- Oregon State has recorded 216 assists its last 329 made baskets (65.6 percent).
- The Beavers are 20-0 this season when leading at halftime.

**IN THE RANKINGS:**

- Oregon State is currently ranked No. 7 in both the Associated Press poll and the WBCA/USA Today Coaches' Poll, matching the highest ranking in program history.
- The Beavers have been ranked in the top 12 of the AP Poll every week since Dec. 29 of 2014, and have been ranked in the coaches poll every week since April 7, 2014.
- OSU is ranked No. 7 in the RPI.
- The Beavers were tabbed as the No. 7 team in the nation in the NCAA Selection Committee's second top-10, which was released on Feb. 15.

**OREGON STATE DEFENSE:**

- The Beavers have held 25 of their 2 opponents to under 40 percent shooting from the floor, and have not allowed an opponent to shoot better than 44.6 percent in any game. Oregon State has also held 12 teams below 30 percent shooting this season, including USC and UCLA in its last two games.
- No team has shot better than 35.3 percent against Oregon State in the team's last 14 games, with opponents shooting 30.6 percent over that stretch.
- Oregon State has allowed just 29 3-pointers over the course of the last 14 games, and has held opponents to 23.9 percent shooting from beyond the arc over its last 11 contests.
- The Beavers have not allowed an opponent to score more than 54 points since Jan. 4 (14-straight games). OSU is surrendering an average of 47.9 points per game over that stretch.

**WITH A WIN:**

- Oregon State will extend its winning streak to 15 games, making it the longest in school history.
- The Beavers would maintain at least a share of first place in the Pac-12 (pending the result of Arizona State vs. USC).
- Oregon State would record its first ever win at Maples Pavilion.
- The Beavers would have back-to-back wins over Stanford for the first time since 1991-92.

**HISTORY VS. STANFORD:**

- The Beavers are 0-28 all-time at Maples Pavilion, dating back to their first ever game at Stanford in 1987.
- Oregon State has beaten Stanford twice in a row on two occasions, first with wins in 1981 and 1987, and again with wins in 1991 and 1992. The Beavers have never topped the Cardinal twice in the same season.
- OSU notched its first win over Stanford since 2001 earlier this season, when it overcame an 11-point lead with seven minutes to play to earn a 58-50 victory.
- Jamie Weisner scored 12 of her 18 points in the fourth quarter to spur the comeback.
- Deven Hunter set a career-high with five 3-pointers and scored 19 points in the game.

**INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS:**

- Sydney Wiese and Stanford's Erica McCall played together as part of Team USA at this summer's World University Games. The duo won the gold medal, defeating Ruth Hamblin and Team Canada in the championship game.

**LAST TIME OUT:**

- The Beavers earned their fourth win over a ranked opponent this season, defeating No. 12/12 UCLA 64-54.
- Oregon State held UCLA to 29.9 percent shooting in the contest.
- Ruth Hamblin, Jamie Weisner and Sydney Wiese combined for 62 of OSU's 64 points in the game.

**SWISH SISTER: Jamie Weisner Quick Hitters**

- Earned Pac-12 Player of the Week honors this week.
- Is one of three player in the Pac-12 with multiple Player of the Week honors this season (Jillian Alleyne, Lili Thompson).
- Named to the Naismith Award Midseason 30.
- Is shooting 48.8 percent from the floor, good for sixth in the Pac-12, and the highest percentage among guards in the conference by over six percent (Nirra Fields - 42.4 percent).
- Is averaging 23.3 points over her last three games.
- Scored 25 points and pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds against UCLA on Sunday.
- Has scored 20 points or more in four of her last seven games.
- Is the seventh player in Oregon State history and 61st player in Pac-12 history with 1,500 career points.
- Her 17.7 points per game is good for fourth in the Pac-12 this season.
- Is second in school history with 229 career 3-pointers, trailing only teammate Sydney Wiese.
- All-Pac-12 honors last season.
- Scored 12 of her 18 points in the fourth quarter of Jan. 17th's game against Stanford, helping the Beavers complete the comeback win.
- Shot 9-for-10 from the floor on Feb. 1 to finish with 25 points against Arizona State.
- Was All-Pac-12 honorable mention in her freshman and sophomore seasons.
- Earned ESPNW National Player of the Week honors in January of 2015.
- Brothers Brett (Western Washington) and Michael (Montana) both played college basketball.

**CANADIAN HAMMER: Ruth Hamblin quick hitters**

- Was named one of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award
- Named a preseason All-American by Lindy's, Athlon and Sporting News
- Made the All-Pac-12 Preseason Team
- Is listed as Lindy's preseason pick for National Defensive Player of the Year.
- Pac-12 Media Player of the Year in 2014-15, and was the conference's consensus Defensive Player of the Year.
- AP Third-Team All-American last year.
- Selected as an Academic All-District honoree for the third-straight year.
- Posted a double-double with 16 points, 15 rebounds and six blocks against UCLA on Sunday.
- Has 39 rebounds in the last three games combined.
- Oregon State's all-time leader in career blocks with 386, and sits second in Pac-12 history. Hamblin would need 16 more rejections to match current Pac-12 record holder Stefanie Kasperski (Oregon, 1987-90).
- Hamblin is the NCAA's active leader in career blocks, leading Breanna Stewart (377).
- Has at least one block in 25-straight games and at least four blocks in five-straight games.
- Became the 20th player in Oregon State history to reach the 1,000 career point mark vs. USC on Jan. 2.
- Earned Second-Team Academic All-America honors last year, posting a 3.86 GPA as a Mechanical Engineering major.
- Is on schedule to graduate a quarter early, finishing her school work at the end of winter quarter.
- She was affectionately dubbed "The Canadian Hammer" by former Oregon State men's basketball standout Joe Burton during her freshman season.

**DISHIN' AND SWISHIN':** Sydney Wiese Quick Hitters

- Is averaging 14.3 points, 5.6 rebounds and 6.3 assists since returning to the starting lineup on Jan. 29.
- Scored 21 points on Sunday, her first 20-point game since Nov. 27.
- 111 of her 118 rebounds this year have been defensive rebounds.
- Became the 19th player in Oregon State history to reach the 1,000-point mark when she knocked down a free throw in the final minutes of the Beavers' game against Idaho on Dec. 12. Wiese is the fourth-fastest player in Oregon State history to hit the milestone (Tanja Kostic, Carol Menken-Schaudt, Judy Shannon).

- Three of the Beavers four signees play for teams ranked ESPN's top-25 high school rankings. Tudor's St. Mary's is the top-ranked team in the nation, followed by Pivec's Lynnwood at No. 20 and Washington's Bishop Gorman at No. 21. Those three squads are a combined 65-1 this season.
