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Media Information

▼ Credentials

All requests for working press, photo and broadcast credentials for Stanford's 2009 home games should be made in writing on company letterhead via fax, e-mail or mail to Jim Young, Senior Assistant Athletic Director, Stanford University, Arrillaga Family Sports Center, 641 East Campus Drive, Stanford, CA 94305-6150. All credentials will be left at the Press Will Call Window at Gate 4. No credential requests will be accepted after 5:00 pm on Thursday of game week. Only media who cover Stanford on a regular basis will be considered for season credentials. Daily credentials will be issued on a priority basis to daily newspapers, originating radio and television stations, national weekly or monthly publications, electronic media outlets and local and regional television crews. Credentials may be picked up in the Stanford Athletic Media Relations Office prior to the day of the game.

▼ Photo Regulations

Photo credentials will be issued to photographers on assignment from legitimate newsgathering organizations. Freelance photographers not on assignment will not be considered for photo credentials. Field photographers must wear an armband at all times in addition to their photo credential. The armband can be picked up on the Fourth Level of the Stanford Stadium SkyBox. NCAA regulations limit shooting of photos to an area outside a five-foot restraining area surrounding the playing field. Photographers may walk behind the team benches to reach the other end of the field.

▼ On-Line Credentialing Policy

Credentials for on-line media services will only be issued to those outlets that are a part of national newsgathering organizations, reaches a broad audience, produces original content and employs full-time journalists. Any exceptions must be approved by the Stanford Media Relations Department.

▼ Will Call

The press will call window is located at Gate 4 on the west side of Stanford Stadium. It will be open three hours prior to kickoff and will remain open until the end of the first half. All members of the media must show proper photo identification when picking up their credentials. Parking passes will not be left at Will Call.

▼ Press Box

The press box is located on the third level of Stanford Stadium Skybox with media access through Gate 4. The press box opens three hours before kickoff and remains open as long as necessary following the game.

▼ Parking

The press parking area is located directly west of the Stanford Stadium Skybox on Galvez Street. Parking is on a first come, first serve basis. Please plan on arriving early to secure a parking spot.

▼ Scouts

Professional teams wishing to scout games at Stanford Stadium may arrange for credentials through the media relations office. Please contact Jim Young at 650-721-1989. In most cases, scouts will be assigned a seat in the main press box.

▼ Tuesday Media Luncheons

Each Tuesday during football season, head coach Jim Harbaugh and selected student-athletes will be on hand for a media luncheon, which starts at 11:30 a.m. in the Athletic Hall of Fame Conference Room located in the Arrillaga Family Sports Center.

▼ Practices

The Stanford football team practices on Elliott Field, which is located directly behind Maples Pavilion, adjacent to the Avery Aquatics Center and Sunken Diamond. Practice sessions begin at approximately 4:00 pm.

▼ Mid-Week Interviews

All interviews with Stanford players and coaches should be arranged through the media relations office by contacting Jim Young. Players will be available to the media at the conclusion of practice on Tuesday and Wednesday only. Media members are not allowed to contact players on the cell phones, in their dormitory rooms, via e-mail or other social networks.

▼ Video Feeds

Videotape highlights of Stanford football games are available each week during the season via the Pacific-10 Conference's satellite feed. For more information, contact the Pac-10 office at (925) 932-4411.

▼ Practice Video and Photos

Only the first 20 minutes of Stanford's daily football practice maybe videotaped or photographed. Please coordinate the shooting of any video with a member of the media relations office.

▼ Press Box Services

Prior to kickoff, the Stanford media relations office will furnish game programs, updated game notes for each team, flip cards and press guides. Last minute lineup changes will be communicated via the press box public address system. During the game, members of the media will be provided with a running play-by-play while quickie stats and drive charts will be distributed at halftime. Following the game, a complete statistical package containing a scoring summary, final team statistics, final individual statistics, complete play-by-play, drive charts, halftime statistics, post-game quotes and notes will be available in the press box.

▼ Telephones

Arrangements for telephone usage should be made directly through Stanford Telecommunications by calling (650) 723-6583.

▼ Internet Access

The Stanford Stadium press box is a wireless facility. A user name and password will be provided to credentialed members of the media on game day.

▼ Postgame Interviews

Postgame interviews are conducted in a designated room adjacent to the Stanford locker room. Following a 10-minute cooling off period, head coach Jim Harbaugh and select players will be available in the interview area. Stanford's locker room is not open to the media. Postgame interviews with the visiting team's head coach and players should be coordinated by the visiting team's SID staff.

XTRA Sports 860

The Radio Home of Stanford Football

All of Stanford's football games this season will be broadcast live on XTRA Sports 860, a 50,000-watt radio station based in San Francisco. XTRA Sports 860 also airs the "Jim Harbaugh Show", "Cardinal Sports Today" and the annual Spring Game in April.

XTRA Sports 860 is one of the oldest radio stations on the West Coast. After serving Modesto and the surrounding area for 73 years, XTRA Sports 860 signed on the air licensed to the city and county of San Francisco on February 1, 2007. XTRA Sports 860 is owned by Pappas Radio of California, LP, an affiliate of Pappas Telecasting Companies, America's largest privately held television broadcast company in terms of household coverage.

Learfield Sports manages multimedia rights for nearly 50 collegiate institutions and associations, including Stanford University. Learfield Sports also manages the marketing partnerships for the Black Coaches & Administrators (BCA) and provides exclusive sports programming to more than 1,000 radio stations throughout the country. Additionally, Team Services, LLC, a Learfield Sports company, specializes in venue naming rights, marketing research and sales consultation.

Pre and Post Game Shows

Each Stanford football radio broadcast on AM 860 KTRB begins one hour before kickoff with a pregame show. The post-game show, which airs for a half hour after the conclusion of the contest, includes analysis of the game and live interviews with Coach Harbaugh and Cardinal players from the Stanford locker room.

Inside Stanford Sports

Inside Stanford Sports featuring head coach Jim Harbaugh airs live on AM 860 KTRB from 8-9:00 p.m. every Monday night during the season from Gordon Biersch Restaurant and Brewery, located at 640 Emerson Street in downtown Palo Alto.

Radio play-by-play voice Dave Flemming, head coach Jim Harbaugh and select players will recap the previous week's game and take a look at upcoming contests.

Fans are welcomed to call in and ask questions of coach Harbaugh and the players. Please check GoStanford.com each week for the call in number.



Dave Flemming Radio Play-by-Play

Dave Flemming returns for his third season as the play-by-play voice of the Cardinal. He also handles play-by-play duties for Stanford basketball during the winter. A native of Alexandria, Virginia, Flemming has been a part of the San Francisco Giants radio broadcast team for the past five seasons and is involved in select television games.

Prior to joining the Giants radio team, Flemming spent three seasons as the play-by-play announcer for the Pawtucket Red Sox, Boston's Triple-A affiliate. Before moving to Pawtucket, he spent the 2000 season handling play-by-play duties for the Visalia Oaks and also served in a dual role as the team's assistant general manager. A native of Alexandria, Va., Flemming received a bachelor's and master's degree from Stanford and a master's degree in broadcast journalism from Syracuse.

Dave and his wife, Jessica, reside in San Francisco with their twins, Katie and Carter.



Todd Husak Radio Color Analyst

Former Stanford quarterback Todd Husak enters his second season in the booth as a color analyst. A two-year starter, he ranks as the school's fifth all-time leading passer with 6,564 yards and also ranks in the Top 10 in career touchdown passes (5th-41) and total offense (5th-6,428). As a senior in 1999, he earned first team All-Pac-10 Conference honors after completing 176-of-308 passes for 2,688 yards and 18

touchdowns, helping Stanford to the Pac-10 title and a Rose Bowl appearance. In his first year as a full-time starter in 1998, Husak completed 233-of-447 passes for 3,092 yards and 17 touchdowns. The passing yardage ranks third on Stanford's all-time single-season list. Husak set Stanford's single-game passing record against Oregon State in 1998 when he completed 26-of-48 passes for a school-record 450 yards.

A sixth round draft pick of the Washington Redskins in 2000, he played five seasons in the NFL with the Redskins (2000), Denver Broncos (2001), New York Jets (2002-03) and Cleveland Browns (2004) before retiring.

Todd and his wife, Kathryn, reside in Palo Alto.



Mike McLaughlin Sideline Reporter

Former Stanford center Mike McLaughlin begins his fourth season as the sideline reporter and co-host of Inside Stanford Sports.

In addition to his broadcast duties with Stanford, McLaughlin has also served as a color analyst for FSN Bay Area and Comcast Sports Net Bay Area. He also served as the color analyst on the radio broadcast of the 2000 and '01 Silicon Valley Football

Classics.

A four-year Cardinal letterwinner from 1996-99, McLaughlin started 46 straight games at the center position and earned first team All-Pac-10 honors as a senior in 1999, helping Stanford to the Pac-10 title and a berth in the Rose Bowl. He also earned first team academic All-Pac-10 honors in 1999.

A native of San Jose, Calif., McLaughlin attended Leland High School where he earned high school All-America honors.

In addition to his duties on Stanford's radio team, Mike is employed at Cisco Systems.



Tim Roye Play-by-Play

Tim Roye enters his 11th season as back-up play-by-play announcer for Stanford football.

This fall Roye will begin his 15th season of handling the play-by-play duties for all Golden State Warriors radio broadcasts. In recent years, Roye has also done television baseball play-by-play work for the Oakland A's and Sacramento Rivercats (the Oakland A's Triple-A affiliate) and television football play-by-play for Cal football.

Prior to his arrival with Golden State in 1995, Roye spent six seasons with the Sacramento Kings' broadcast team. Prior to his work at KHTK, Roye served as sports director at KFBK in Sacramento for five years (1989-94) and handled radio play-by-play and television color analyst duties for the Sacramento Gold Miners of the Canadian Football League.

Roye spent two years in the Phoenix market from 1987-89, serving as a talk show host for KTAR radio and a correspondent for the Arizona Cardinals Radio Network. He also served as the color analyst for the Arizona State University Basketball Network and called play-by-play for the Phoenix Firebirds and Sun Devil baseball teams. Following his graduation from Utica College in New York, Roye spent eight years (1978-86) as the sports director at Utica's WIBX-WNYZ radio. He later moved to Birmingham, Alabama, where he was the sports director at WVOK radio from 1986-87.
